Dear People of God,

Unless I'm way off the calendar, next weekend is Mother's Day. It's a great chance to thank our mother for making sure we're here today. Sadly, today many expectant mothers make another choice and no one will be around to send them flowers, bring by a box of candy or take them out to dinner. For some of us, Mother's Day means a drive to the cemetery to remember our moms, say a prayer and perhaps listen for that spiritual voice which tells us they're doing ok. Mothers hold a special place in our hearts and perhaps that's why this entire month of May is dedicated to "Mary, Mother of God, and mother of the Church and our mother." Mary's title "Mother of God" is the second oldest title applied to her, after Blessed Virgin, which was assigned in the gospel of Luke. Of course, the title derives from Jesus and was given at Ephesus where a significant gathering of Catholic bishops was taking place in the fourth century. A major brouhaha had developed over just how Jesus functioned. Was he all God disguised as a human, had the human element been literally burned out by the indwelling of the divine? What was the person of Jesus? The bishops were in some disagreement and a battle raged on the floor of the Basilica Church of St. John the Evangelist on 22 June 431 A.D. You can read it if you read ancient Greek in a magnificent series of works simply called *Manci* (for the compiler, whose folio work includes the secretaries' notes which is why I recommend it over *Denzinger* or *Tanner*, both of whom have English language translations of the actual conclusions of the councils – if you find the forty plus volume set at a garage sale for \$1.00 a volume, snap it up for the parish library – it's a magnificent collection worth thousands of dollars – *Manci's* side-bar notes describe the weather that day (very hot and sunny), who was sick so didn't attend, and which bishop brought the best swordsmen to support his point of view). The Council developed a clearly laid out understanding of the union of real divine and real human in Jesus, a union so close and intimate that if Mary is the mother of the human Jesus she must also be the mother of the divine Jesus, hence the *Mother of God*. Throughout the month the Church celebrates Mary as the first and best disciple of Jesus. The church celebrates her being a spouse and with Joseph revealing the pattern and model of marriage. The church celebrates her being a parent who knew when to discipline Jesus (Lk. 2:41-52), when to remind him to get on with his public ministry (Jn. 2:1-10), and when to stand back and allow Jesus to fulfill the plan of the Father in Heaven (Jn. 19:24b-27). As the model *par excellence* of discipleship, spousal partnership, and parenting, Mary becomes the mother of us all, giving good advice through her example, interceding with God on our behalf and reminding Jesus her son that he made us his sisters and brothers in love. Take time during this month of Mary to reflect on how her modeling might help you become a better Christian.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Health News from the Parish Nurse for May 6, 2018

How to Buy Medicines Safely from an Online Pharmacy.

Ever been tempted to buy your medicines from an online pharmacy or another website? Protect yourself and your family by using caution when buying medicine online. There are many pharmacy websites that operate legally and offer convenience, privacy, and safeguards for purchasing medicines. But the U.S. Food and Drug Administration warns that there are many rogue online pharmacies that claim to sell prescription medicines at deeply discounted prices, often without requiring a valid prescription. These Internet-based pharmacies often sell unapproved or counterfeit medicines outside the safeguards followed by licensed pharmacies. These rogue sites often prominently display a Canadian flag, but may actually be operated by criminals from the other side of the globe with no connection to Canada. Medicines bought from these websites can be dangerous and may put your health at risk. How can you tell if an online pharmacy is operating legally? The FDA's BeSafeRx can help you identify and avoid fake online pharmacies.
