Dear People of God,

Time is the chain that binds our lives, that checks our progress and frustrates our dreams. I'm sure somebody along the way said that but I notice that time has flown and the Season of Easter is rapidly coming to its end. Many of us remember the Easter Duty and for those who don't, allow me to repeat it. If you have any grave sins, those which destroy the relationship between you and God or you and somebody else, you are to confess them any time between Ash Wednesday and Pentecost Sunday. Everyone of age is to go participate in the Eucharist between those same two dates. As Pentecost looms in the immediate horizon, you might want to consider whether either of those requirements (minimal expectations to claim to being a Catholic) applies to you. Some of you may also remember the good old days when Ascension was celebrated on Thursday, the fiftieth day after Easter in accordance with the gospels. Recognizing that modern culture doesn't respect religious holy days, the Church allowed Ascension to be transferred to the Sunday following the fiftieth day after Easter if the Episcopal Conference gave its ok, and so it is that here in the United States we come together on a Sunday to recall that Jesus went home to heaven. For some that's difficult to accept; why didn't he stick around and solve all the problems of the world? For the committed Christian it's a rare good day because Jesus' departure signals his trust in us to do the work of solving all the world's problems. That's a rare degree of trust: God telling us we can do God's work! That ought to excite us because Jesus didn't walk off and leave us without the authority to do the work. Indeed, he provided us with his presence in the sacraments. Perhaps we need a refresher in just what the divine presence means because many of us fall far short in the delivery department when it comes to fulfilling the Great Command: Go out and teach all nations, baptizing them in the Name... Jesus specifies baptism because it's that sacrament which initiates us into the real power of God, power to do what Jesus did if we have faith the size of a mustard seed. Any of us baptized have that faith but are all too often afraid to test it for fear we might not, but in baptism we got the power to do exactly what Jesus did. Fear deprives us of access to the real power God gives us and that's why over the two thousand years since Jesus left for home we haven't solved all the problems in the world. Yet Jesus still trusts us to get the job done which is why we gather to celebrate Ascension and hear Jesus and hundreds of those who came after remind us: Do not be afraid.




