Dear People of God,

This Monday I will be celebrating thirty-five years of priestly service to the Diocese of Toledo. In January I turned 70 and arrived at the opportunity to retire (I'm sticking around for another five years at least). It's been a great experience and a wonderful life (wouldn't that make a great name for a movie or something?) and it has me thinking about vocations and the shortage we've been experiencing for some years now. Three decades ago I was part of a class of seven men ordained to provide sacramental leadership for the people of God throughout the diocese of Toledo. One is currently on loan to the U.S. Army, another has died in the meantime, which means there are five of us still at work. This past May we ordained three young men, the year before that only one. Unless something happens to inspire more young men to enter the seminary we face a serious problem in staffing our parishes. Many believe it's already serious including some of the priests who are attempting to keep three or even four parishes open with no help in meeting the need for sacramental services but plenty of complaints that somebody isn't getting the services they believe they ought to be getting. For some years now we've had a diocesan prayer for vocations not only to the priesthood, but to diaconate, vowed religious life and spirited lay leadership. We've had specific prayers for more men to answer the call to priesthood and have asked the people in the pews to pray. That will eventually work because God answers prayer, but in the short term I'd like to invite all of us to be more conscientious about watching for young men who seem to be "set apart" by God for sacramental leadership. We ought to encourage those young men, and perhaps all young men, to consider whether they are being summoned to a wonderful life (after a couple of our secular leaders have been caught plagiarizing, I suppose I ought to mention that the expression "it's a wonderful life" was borrowed from the title of a Frank Capra movie). There are great opportunities in the priesthood to be more than a pastor, although that is a great blessing in itself. I have been given the opportunity to do advanced studies and hold a doctorate thanks to the opportunities available through the priesthood. For some years I traveled the U.S. doing parish missions and retreats. I have had the good fortune to be a teacher (I spent the first seventeen years of my priesthood teaching) and continue to enjoy an occasional session of teaching so that I can continue to do something I truly like doing. I know priests of this diocese who have written novels, others who have published collections of poetry, others who have been called to Rome to assist the Holy See in its universal call to evangelize the whole world. I know several diocesan priests who had the great good blessing to work as missionaries and discovered the poor whom God calls on us to serve. Most people are not aware that the physicist who developed the trigger for the atom bomb was a Jesuit priest, a priest serves as chaplain of the U.S. House, a priest serves as sideline moral advisor to several NFL coaches. Encouraging young men to think priesthood opens up for them a vast panorama of careers which, layered into their sacramental work, can truly change the face of the earth (to avoid another claim of plagiarizing, that comes from one of the Psalms). Perhaps all of us could say a word of encouragement to someone this summer and maybe turn around the shortage and create an abundance of workers for the harvest.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
