Dear People of God,

A question came up at Bible Study recently about the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. *Is Jesus present corporeally or spiritually?* In other words, is the presence of Jesus real in a physical way or real in a spiritual way? The answer to that question is to avoid getting into an abstract discussion of **transubstantiation** the philosophical explanation which was worked out in the High Renaissance by some of the Church's greatest philosophers, but to go and ask a second grader on the eve of her First Communion. She'll tell you, *yes it's really Jesus*; and when you ask how that can happen, she'll promptly respond *Because he's God and God can do what God wants to do*. What God wants is the perfect unity between Jesus and us, which you can find in the Gospel of John, the Last Supper Discourse (13:31-17:26). To accomplish that end, Jesus invites us to transcend time and join him at the same Last Supper at which the Twelve were gathered for their own First Communion. If you listen to the words of institution at Mass you'll discover that the actions predicted are in the future, not the past; we're there, with Jesus, as he reminds us he will die for us, he will offer his blood for the salvation of the many and, as we know from our history, he will rise again on the third day. The words are clear: this **is** my body, this **is** the chalice of my blood. It's the real presence of Jesus: body and soul, humanity and divinity *so that they may be one as you and I are one*. Of course the *how* behind something that certainly doesn't resemble the physical reality of Jesus remains a mystery. It's a sacrament and sacraments are all mysterious because they're God's most intimate business, so richly divine that they are beyond our limited human understanding. Perhaps, once we attain to the Kingdom it will all become clear, but in the here and the now our faith, our belief, our hope, our trust is in the reality of what Jesus says he wants to do, to become one with you and me so that we might experience the love of God in that unique and powerful manner God wills. In the meantime we must default to the definition provided by transubstantiation. We need to know what *trans* means, what *substance* is, and the action which moves the substance of bread and wine to become the actual body and blood of Jesus without changing the external aspects of what was but no longer is bread and wine. The word *trans* means to cross over and *substance* is from two Latin words which mean under and stand still. In combination the word means under what externally apprehensible signs (seeing, feeling, hearing, smelling, tasting) does the object become known to the human observer. For a more expanded look at transubstantiation you might want to dig out your *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and go to paragraphs 1373 through 1377. You'll find the words of a couple of well-known Catholic philosophers and the words of the Council of Trent's solemn declaration regarding the real presence in the Eucharist.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

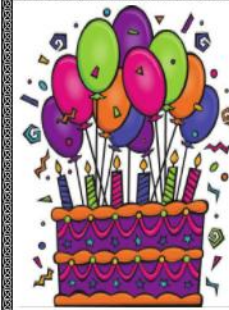

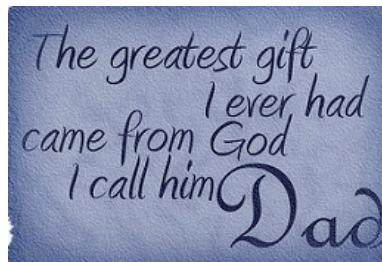
