Dear People of God,

As we approach the end of the fiscal year I always pause to consider the kindness and generosity of those who work so diligently to support the parish both in its physical needs and in its ministerial outreach. This last year the finance committee and I came to the parish and asked that you prayerfully reflect on your own financial condition and that of the parish and perhaps make a pledge to continue to support the work the parish is trying to accomplish. The response was gratifying and I want to take time to thank everyone who participated in the increased giving program. When all the numbers are added up and our Annual Report is published I think you'll feel good about what you've accomplished. Not only has the overall income gone up but we've seen a magnificent response to all of those other, added collections for special needs articulated by the United States Conference of Bishops. And the ACA has also done well this year. Beyond that, there has been a nice increase in the number of regular contributors, the families and individuals whose weekly offering assists the parish in meeting its daily requirements to keep the lights on and provide a safe, clean environment for the worship and adoration of our God. If you have not made a pledge, or are not regularly using envelopes, may I invite you to join the other members of your parish who are making what we do possible? The Church recommends that all of us work together and not depend on a small portion of the people to carry the load. The Church suggests that we consider all of the many charities which ask us for support and make the Church one of those we finally choose from among the many. Traditionally the notion of the tithe is mentioned. In the Old Testament the tithe was the first fruits of the farmer or herder (everybody had a farm and either raised crops or animals). No specific percentage was ever demanded or even suggested because the author of the Old Testament (God inspired the texts so reflects God's plan) understood that human beings have different needs and abilities so should do what each can do and no more. But by the same token no less. Somewhere along the passage of the centuries the tithe came to be thought of as 10% of our ordinary income, which is the *work of our hands*. That's why you'll often see in the documentation for increased giving a scale based on one's hourly wage, not on all the money we might happen to bring in from other sources (we can and probably should offer a gift for those monies). A fixed income can easily be translated into an hourly wage by dividing a month's retirement check by 200 (five weeks of forty hour work) If we all offered God and God's work an hour's wages the work of the parish every Sunday, and its proper upkeep, could all be maintained. So, again, **thank you for your support**. Take a look around you, stop by through the week to share in or just watch Ministry, and you'll see what your kindness is making happen. By the way, with vacationing season at hand, I just want to remind regular donors that you can drop your weekly envelope into the collection at any Catholic church in the United States or Canada and it'll show up in the mail here at the parish office.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

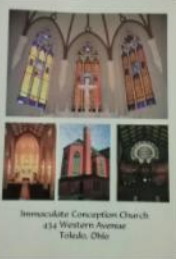
