Dear People of God,

During the summer months many of us have the opportunity to take time off to travel, visit Cedar Point, picnic at Maumee Bay or take in a concert down on the river while kayaking from the Middle grounds. As you enjoy those opportunities for leisure and refreshment, please don't forget the many people in our neighborhood who can't travel, who won't be going to Cedar Point or anywhere else because of the grinding poverty which continues to vex our community. Here at the parish we're well known, and rightly so, for the generosity of our outreach. However, during the summer months, when many of us are up at the cottage or down at the beach, the food pantry begins to show signs of reduced capacity to serve because nobody's around to keep the shelves full. As you pack for vacation think to pack a box or bag with a few items for the pantry and drop it off before your flight leaves the airport, your train leaves the depot or your car heads for the traffic jam on the Interstate. Your kind donations of canned goods and non-perishable items can be left at the parish office any time and it'll all get to people who do need it. As you set aside a picnic lunch for your trip to the zoo, take time to pack something for the pantry. As you look over the availability of restaurants in your out-of-state destination, think of making something available for our many clients who rely on us for their next meal. If you're the typical gardener who planted a dozen tomato plants, and just as many cucumbers, peppers and other good things so that you reap a harvest beyond your ability to use it all, pack up a peck of the overflowing bounty for the use of the pantry. We certainly get plenty of veggies from other sources, but often your items, fresh from the garden, would be far more useful and tastier. If you have children or grandchildren, why not add a few extra child-appreciated treats to your donation to the pantry for the children of families who visit us. Packets of pre-sweetened Kool Aide, a bottle or can of fruit punch, a box of sweetened cereal (and perhaps a half gallon of milk to go with it), a bag of assorted candies would go a long way toward making a few kids in the neighborhood happy, as would the donation of children's books which are always appreciated. And, should you be planning a staycation, why not volunteer to work at the pantry and see for yourself how greatly appreciated that place and its workers are by the people being served. The pantry could easily be opened more often than it is but the lack of volunteers means we can't be open and often we aren't open when the real emergencies show up at the door. To unload and shift cartons and crates it would help if we had a few strong backs on hand and that means a few men willing to spend some time helping others, both those in need and the staff of the pantry who might not be able to lift heavy crates. Our pantry relies on you as both a donor and a volunteer so its success is your part of parish ministry. As you take off for vacation please keep in mind what you can do to be of assistance even while away.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

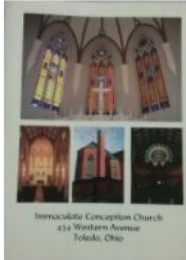

Health News from the Parish Nurse for July 15, 2018

Sleep and Health. What Schools Can Do: Provide Sleep Education. Schools can add sleep education to the K-12 curriculum to help children and adolescents learn why sleep is important to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Lessons in sleep patterns and sleep disorders, snoring, drowsy driving, and insomnia are among topics teachers can cover in the classroom to help students develop healthy sleep habits. Sleep education programs in school may result in significantly longer weekday and weekend total sleep time and improved sleep hygiene (habits that support good sleep) after completion. However, more research is needed to determine how best to maintain these improvements long term. One possible strategy is to incorporate refresher sessions for students. *To be continued next week...*
