Dear People of God,

Summer is a great time to get away from it all and enjoy the sun, the water and a vacation (or a staycation for many who prefer to spend quiet time on the back deck, front porch, or at nearby attractions like our amazing zoo or the nationally renowned museum of art). However, vacation or staycation ought not be a time when we see ourselves taking time off from our worship and glorification of God. Regardless of where we go for that vacation, it's easy to locate a Catholic parish with a convenient time for gathering to praise and adore our God who is, after all, the source of the places we go to see, to experience, and to enjoy. I recall as a kid when we'd go on vacation my mom and Dad would head to our home parish to leaf through the *National Catholic Directory* to find where the Catholic churches were along the route of our vacation trip. If we happened to make a detour from the plan Dad laid out he'd make sure to stop and ask for directions, which led us to a few out of the way and unexpected gems, especially in the South where Catholics were a rare item in the good old days when I was a kid (I remember discovering the Black Catholic Church as a ten year old when Dad asked where to find a Catholic church and the gas station attendant directed us back into the wilds of northern Florida to a little clapboard church where Mom made us all sing the spirituals with everybody else)! Once or twice we'd head for a parish which had some connection to 'home', like the Catholic church in Toledo, Ontario while vacationing on Rice Lake, or the little church of St. Mary atop a hill with a great view at Wilno, Ontario while on a rock collecting trip because Mom's family came from the area of Poland settled by the people at Wilno. One summer our entire vacation was spent driving from parish to parish in the Diocese of Toledo just to see those other parishes. If there was a shrine or monastery, Dad would stop in so we could have a look and say a prayer or, as at the famous shrine of the Cross in the Woods in the Upper Peninsula, climb the stairs on our knees which us kids did not see as at all penitential! With the internet providing several sites which give Mass times and churches all around the world, it should be easy to find a place where we can join in the celebration of God's goodness to us and to the people we join for the weekend celebration. Walking in the door of an unfamiliar church is a great way to evangelize just by being present. People see that famous Ohio license plate in Kansas, California or some other state and realize that this wonderful old Church of ours has a universal scope. And if we happen to be overseas, our American accent as we sing or pray will let people know that same sense of the larger Church and perhaps lead us to some wonderful new friendships as we visit with the people of the parish. As you begin to consider a summer get-away, think of getting away to another church or parish where your faith can find the same refreshment you seek for your mind and body. And don't forget to say *thank you* to those other parishes and churches by dropping something into the collection in addition to your regular envelope for the parish here. No matter where you leave an envelope, it finds its way back to your home base.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

In the fall, we will resume our Bible Study following the Tuesday morning mass. More information to follow.

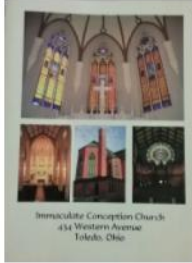

Health News from the Parish Nurse August 5, 2018

Opioids and Chronic Pain. Many Americans suffer from chronic pain, a major public health concern in the United States. Patients with chronic pain deserve safe and effective pain management. At the same time, our country is in the midst of a prescription opioid overdose epidemic. The amount of opioids prescribed and sold in the US quadrupled since 1999, but the overall amount of pain reported hasn't changed. There is insufficient evidence that prescription opioids control chronic pain effectively over the long term, and there is evidence that other treatments can be effective with less harm.
