Dear People of God,

I was away for Priests' Convocation recently and somebody asked "how was your vacation, Father?" Well, Convocation is at an ideal vacation spot, but it's hardly a vacation. The whole point of the event is to provide an opportunity for continued spiritual growth as a presbyterium, the entire body of priests of the diocese. Our days began with prayer, brought us together for sessions with presenters and provided an opportunity for daily Mass together and gave us the opportunity for reconciliation and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. It also left some hours open for relaxation and reflection, so I reflected and relaxed one afternoon on a wine tour of the area round Huron and Vermillion. You might be surprised how many excellent wineries we have right here in our own Diocese. I personally like Quarry Hill for the magnificent views from the tasting room and terrace. The wine is pretty good, too. If you're looking for one closer to home, drive out Corduroy Road (Consaul) just beyond the rail yards and you'll find Johlin, the oldest bonded winery in Ohio, not five miles from the parish. The young operator is third generation wine maker and does a really good job, making some very good wines. Some of the priests took an afternoon for golf or sail boating, but the real emphasis of the days away was prayer and reflection so that we can return to the parishes and offices more alert to the signs of the times and prepared to respond to them in a compassionate and life-giving manner. Convocation helps us prevent stagnation and opens us to new avenues of ministry or new ways to do old ministry. It helps us see the priesthood not as an individual work being done alone, but as what it is, a part in the priesthood of the bishop. It offers us priests the reminder that the people for whom we minster are richly blessed by God and deserve our attention, our support and our finest work done on their behalf. By the way, the deacons also gather for a time away to reflect and grow in their own understanding of diaconal ministry of service. And speaking of deacons, the new class preparing for the diaconate will be forming this fall. Our own Jeff Gralak has petitioned the Diocese for admission to the new Deacon Class. Please keep Jeff and all of the others and the priests and deacons in your prayers so that we might all truly represent the Christ in compassion, love and service.



The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Health News from the Parish Nurse August 12, 2018

Understanding Prescription Opioids. Opioids are natural or synthetic chemicals that relieve pain by binding to receptors in your brain or body to reduce the intensity of pain signals reaching the brain. Opioid pain medications are sometimes prescribed by doctors to treat pain. Common types include: Hydrocodone (e.g., Vicodin), Oxycodone (e.g., OxyContin), Oxymorphone (e.g., Opana), and Morphine. Opioids can have serious risks including addiction and death from overdose. As many as 1 in 4 people receiving prescription opioids long term in a primary care setting struggles with addiction.
