Dear People of God,

Over the last couple of weeks we've seen the release of a filing by a Grand Jury in Pennsylvania, with ensuing calls for the resignation of bishops and Cardinals, and a Pastoral Letter from our own Bishop regarding the scandal of priestly abuse of children. What the Grand Jury published has been in the public domain for a while as part of the attempt by the bishops of Pennsylvania to both offer an apology for what occurred and to assure people of all faiths that steps are being taken to help prevent such atrocities in the future. In fact, the Catholic Church took a leadership role in looking into the causes and methodologies for preventing sexual predation of children. A team of specialists in a number of fields at John Jay University assembled an in-depth study which offered a lot of intriguing statistics tracing the history, development and current attempts to thwart these kinds of abuses, a study unlike any done by anyone else, including the government agencies which we charged with looking into allegations of abuse. The monumental *John Jay Study* examines the Church's scandal in the larger picture of sexual abuse of minors as a human problem, one which affects both men and women of every age and across the panorama of professional and vocational careers. Although the Study has been published for several years now, few government or media outlets have read it, or looked into its findings. You may wish to do so; it's available on the USCCB website and you'll find a lot of internet chatter on whether the report was accurate, honest or all another attempt to 'cover up.' Tragically, statistics available at the local police department or prosecutor's office will tell us all that the abuse of children - sexual physical, emotional and mental - goes on every day all around us and most of it will not be reported because the primary abusers are members of the family - mothers and fathers, aunts and uncles, brothers and sisters and other trusted family members, none of whom are either required to or want to report on what's going on. We see coverage of this tragedy almost daily: children locked in cages, starved nearly to death, forced to live deprived of freedom to run and play as we all want our children to do. As a people who are enlivened to the dignity of God's presence in all others, we are all obliged to make ourselves aware of the underlying causes of such behavior and root it out of our own lives and those whom we care about and love. Doing that will go a long way to eradicating the problematic behaviors in the culture around us, a culture which has so degraded the value of human life that an "anything goes" attitude promotes many to play out their interior urges in destructive ways. Pope Paul VI, Cardinal Bernardin, Pope St. John Paul II and others have repeatedly urged us to ennoble human life from beginning to natural end and warned of the dangers of failing to do so. Let us all attest to the dignity of others, regardless of age, race, creed or any other factor, and in doing so provide a measure of healing, protection and prevention of abuses of all kinds.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
