Dear People of God,

I hope everyone knows that I'll be completing a term of office this next year. Priests are assigned for a period of six years and as difficult as it is for me to realize time has passed so quickly, my sixth is coming to an end in July of 2019. At the end of a term, I could be transferred to some other assignment where either I or the Diocese believe my gifts could be better put to use (I have been transferred several times for that reason) or I could be renewed for a second term of six years. As part of the process of determining whether a priest should stay or move on, during the final year the priest undergoes an evaluation in which many of the parishioners he serves are invited to take part and tell the diocese whether their pastor fits the needs of the parish. Fifty people will be selected randomly from the latest ACA (Annual Catholic Appeal) contributor list and sent contact information to do an on-line survey. By now that cohort may already have the information. Staff and a few people I think should be doing a review will also be contacted. To get that list, I have consulted my staff and would be looking for key individuals who are attuned to the work-a-day processes involved in keeping the parish afloat financially and magisterially (they are not just a few people I choose so I can get some rave reviews but are selected because they know the parish, its people and the needs to be met over the next few years). Those names have to be sent to the Diocese by the end of October and the people named will be contacted very soon after that. In addition, I will do a self-review. All of this is collected by the Priests' Personnel Board and factors into its work with the Bishop to determine where a priest's talents and gifts can best be put to use in serving God's people around the diocese. The insights of the people who turn in an evaluation are considered extremely important so if you are among those called upon, please follow the instructions to do the on-line survey. It's a confidential process so those who get the contact information are asked not to pass it on to a hundred of their best friends, but to make their own effort to honestly and objectively look at the parish, its needs, and whether they believe I have addressed or could address over the next few years those needs in a meaningful way. Thanks to all who will be assisting in this evaluation process.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Diocese of Toledo Safe Environment Program In Full Compliance with USCCB Norms


