Dear People of God,

Every now and then I get unsigned letters from people: some might be parishioners, others from somebody who reads the bulletin on line or who may stop by on a weekend, and I suppose some are because of the work I do for the Diocese. I have no idea what might be in those letters because I don't read them. They wind up in "file 13" where I believe they belong. I may have missed out on winning some African lottery that only requires that I send in \$15,000 first, but in general I don't think I've missed anything by tossing unsigned things into the trash. Allow me to explain. At the bottom of this letter, I put my name down so people know who said what I'm saying. At Mass people, even strangers visiting, know who I am because my name is listed in the schedule of Masses. My name is on the front of the Bulletin as Pastor and my name is in the Diocesan Directory linking me to the various positions I hold in service to the people of God. I have my name out there so people can comment, complain, advise, contradict, admonish, teach or do whatever they might want to do. I don't hide behind the wall when I preach; I don't write these letters anonymously. Neither should those who wish to communicate with me. People who want to tell me something should be proud enough of their own point of view, their own opinion, their own background to put themselves on the same line I do every time I write a letter or preach a homily or issue a Sentence through the Tribunal. It's common courtesy and allows a dialogue to begin whereas anonymity means there can be no conversation, no meeting of the minds. As I've already said, I throw unsigned letters out without reading them so I don't have any idea where a conversation might begin. I suspect that most people who write anonymous letters are actually talking to themselves, attempting to articulate something about which they feel great passion and excitement, but which they feel might lead to a backlash, resentment, or anger which could be directed at them if the recipient knew who sent it. I always write my letters to people with whom I have a gripe and set them aside a day or two, then reread them and usually rewrite them before putting my name on them so I don't accidentally make some foolish remark or ad hominem attack, but then I sign them and send them on in hopes of getting a response (I like to write Congress if only to get a franked envelope to add to my collection – they rarely write back but only send a nice mimeographed form letter). I would invite anyone who has a complaint, comment, or whatever to write me, but please, if you expect me to read what you write, have the courtesy to add your name.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




