Dear People of God,

Every now and then someone will stop me after Mass to express their feelings on topical issues, among them politics. During the lead up to the recent Election Day, there was quite a lot of that given the highly charged political climate in which we find ourselves today. I rarely take sides in these discussions because the Church is restricted in what it can and cannot do regarding the political process here in the US. As I hope everyone knows, the Catholic Church is a 501(c)(3) organization, a non-profit charity and therefore more or less tax-exempt. The designation is given to the Church as recognized in the Kennedy Directory [more formally referred to as the *Official Catholic Directory*], a mammoth book issued each year listing all the dioceses, parishes, schools and other Catholic institutions under the aegis of the USCCB [United States Conference of Catholic Bishops]. It's a handy resource when you want to know where a particular parish is located so you can send them a visitor's envelope dropped into the Sunday collection, but it also serves to identify who can claim the exemption under the 501(c)(3). As I also hope everyone knows, 501(c)(3) organizations are restricted in their political life and may not campaign for candidates for political office. They may campaign for issues which are on the ballot, like tax levies, constitutional amendments and the like, but cannot take a stand on a particular person running for office. We can't post signs on our property supporting this or that candidate; we can't propose one person over another in the bulletin. If we do want to comment on candidates, we have to be very careful to list everybody and then do some sort of comparison, like *this one proposes... while that one proposes...* so that we're informing our people, not telling them who we think they ought to elect. Because there's only one designation for everybody, if one place or parish or priest standing up as if on behalf of the Church were to begin campaigning for somebody, the entire Church could lose its designation and therefore its tax exemption even though everybody else was obeying the law. By the way, that 501(c)(3) is only for the IRS and what a parish or diocese makes by way of income. I suspect that most parishes and probably a lot of dioceses could substantiate a yearly loss, but as I recall the IRS regulations, if you do that five years running, the IRS could determine that you're operating a hobby and tax you anyway! State and local governments give a tax exemption for property being used for religious purposes. That means that rectories (the area not being used as office space), land held for future use, and other property not actually being used for outreach, education and other parish-related services is taxed just like any other property. It's rare that a parish or diocese doesn't have to pay some taxes, so in the annual reports you may notice a category for "taxes, licenses and fees" because we own property for future use which isn't being used now for religious purposes. "Little Blue Books" Advent Books for Sunday, December 2, are available in the back of church today. Daily meditations during Advent help us to truly prepare the way.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
