Dear People of God,

Last week I mentioned that the Church is a 501(c)(3) organization, a tax-exempt charity. Someone was reminded by that letter that in the good old days, there used to be a year-end invitation for people to make a last-minute “tax deductible” gift to the parish to reduce their tax liability. For a couple of reasons, we don’t do that anymore, although if anyone has some extra money in their charitable giving portfolio, we’d be glad to accept it and would do so at any time of the year. So, why don’t we make a concerted effort to find year-end donors? Over the past few years the IRS has changed the income tax model so that it’s difficult for most people in the typical Catholic parish to take deductions over and above the well-known “standard deduction.” That has cut into the number of people who might be able to benefit from a tax break by giving a little more to the parish as tax time approaches and they see the “amount due” line on their return. The IRS has also tightened up on charitable giving so that a smaller total charitable gift can be taken as a deduction. Again, not a lot of people are in the category that could find an advantage from a last-minute offering to the work of the parish. Professional fund raisers now tell us that a third issue has arisen: the people who can afford to give are being besieged by far more worthy causes than ever before and tend to divide their total charitable gift over a larger pool of charities. In the past we attempted to seek out those who could make an extra offering using the program Gift for Mary. We dropped that effort in hopes of seeing an increase in weekly offerings (which is a great success so thanks to all who made a pledge and then kept it). However, there is still a way any of us could make a special “last minute” gift to the parish. I’ll call it what a friend of mine called his gift to a parish in Lima: the “**Tenth Child**.” It’s also a great way to put off giving until after our departure from this life to the Kingdom (where we don’t need any money) and requires only a small insertion in your will (I hope the lessons of Prince and Aretha Franklin have gotten our attention and all of us have a current, up-to-date will) leaving 10% of your net estate to the parish. That may mean a large bequest for some or a small one for others, but it’s a way to assure that every one of us can continue to support the parish even when we can no longer be physically present. I know that a few people can and do think of a much larger bequest than 10%, but if everyone made the parish their Tenth Child, the effects could be truly miraculous. For those who have no estate to leave to anyone, let alone 10% to the parish, why not leave behind a document to be presented to the parish which promises your intercession in heaven on behalf of the parish and its work? Kind of a “spiritual support” letter which could be put in a special file and reserved as a reminder that our presence continues long after we take physical leave of this life for that, promised in the Kingdom.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
