Dear People of God,

As the New Year dawns it's customary to make resolutions which most of us will have forgotten by the time the last football bowl game has become a happy (or not so happy) memory. The term resolution occurs in one of our sacramental liturgies you know, and it's for more than once a year consideration. It's in the Act of Contrition when the Penitent says I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace. . . The term means to solve a problem anew, or in some way we haven't as yet attempted so that success is assured in a way that is both more powerful and longer lasting. Our New Year's resolutions generally have to do with behaviors, perhaps losing a few pounds by watching the calories, getting more exercise, watching less television or whatever. Our spiritual resolutions in reciting the Act of Contrition have to do with behaviors as well, usually attempts to change some bad habits we've developed in our faith life. If we stop and think about it, changing habits is a really difficult job and is always easier if we have someone who is there to advise and model for us the behavior we hope to achieve. Not just a poster of someone we wish we looked like but a real person who can be alerted when we need a kick in the pants to stick to our resolutions. Many people hire personal trainers to keep them on track with behavioral changes that affect wellness and performance, others rely on a friend who has the behavioral trait we hope to acquire to replace that bad habit. In our spiritual life we may need someone just like that, a Spiritual Director with whom we regularly discuss our journey of faith, the habits we want to eradicate end those we want to pick up. We all have the perfect spiritual director in Jesus, present in any of the seven sacraments; however we really need to get focused on the real presence if we're to take full advantage of Jesus' constant willingness to be an advisor, guide and model. That means taking time (which may require a resolution itself) to prepare for the spiritual dereliction session Jesus will have with us. Quieting ourselves from the distractions of the world around us isn't easy, and perhaps even more difficult than turning aside from the candy aisle at the grocery or flipping off the remote when we've reached the allotted time limit for television watching. There's no simple method for getting into the right frame of mind to encounter Jesus where he's most present, in the Eucharist. Some people find it helpful to force themselves to spend time before the Blessed Sacrament in a Holy Hour and there are a few parishes around the city which offer the opportunity 24-7 to do just that. Others make use of the Liturgy of the Hours, the universal prayer of the Church which is based on the recitation over a period of days of all 150 Psalms with attached readings and prayers. Still others arrive early at Mass to spend a bit of time just watchfully waiting for the liturgy to begin and then focusing on the preparatory readings and the celebration of Christ Present at the altar. Whether making New Year's resolutions or those pertinent to your spiritual well-being, may God assist you in keeping them so that you may be a better person tomorrow than you are today.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Snow Emergency

Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in the geographic area are also cancelled.
