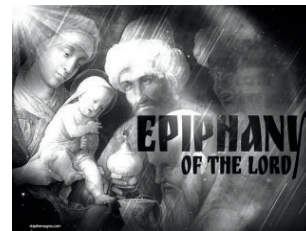

Dear People of God,

I have been told by not a few more conservative Catholics that we ought not be using the church for secular presentations with an underscored note that *I certainly hope Jesus wasn't in the Tabernacle when you do that*. I assure you that Jesus is always reserved off the altar when we have a special presentation but I wonder if that pleases our God or not. Did Jesus come to share our lives only when we're at Church? I think not. In fact, from the gospels we know that Jesus was in Jerusalem for most of the favored holy days celebrated by the Jews, and I stress the word celebrate. Jewish festivals didn't take place in the Holy of Holies, but all over the city and in the Temple courtyards, in the neighboring fields and orchards and consisted of dancing singing and merriment of just about every kind because for the Jews God was a God of joy and life to be feted where life was lived. Jesus first miracle, as recorded in the gospel of John, was at a party, not a worship service (weddings for the Jews, as for most ancient civilizations, were a family event, not a church event). I cannot but think that the God who gives talents in abundance turns his back to avoid listening to someone sing or closing his eyes to avoid seeing someone dance. So, that leads me to a question I ask myself and perhaps we all ought to be asking: have we gone so far to be pious that we've limited the humanity of Jesus so that, as he said of his own people in Nazareth, he cannot do any great work here? If we look to the letters of St. Paul, or the Revelations of John, we find any number of songs and hymns which speak to the majesty of God in the world, a world to whom the Father gave the son so that, as John writes in his gospel, the world might be known as beloved of God: "for God so loved the world, that he sent his only begotten son. . ." The world is a big place and locking that world out of the church may be a terrible mistake that compromises our ability to be the messengers of the Good News God intends. I find it difficult to believe that a Jesus kept apart from the world he loved can truly laugh with us, cry with us, die with us and bring us to eternal life as he wants that eternal life to be. Yes, we need to know when sacred silence is necessary but we ought also to be making *a joyful noise unto the Lord*. Give it some thought.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Snow Emergency

Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in the geographic area are also cancelled.
