Dear People of God,

Well, mentioning practicalities which have become semi-sacred “necessities” raises a few questions about what some of those might be. Here’s a short list: The priest’s chasuble is a cape borrowed from the secular world in an era when churches didn’t have boilers and heating systems. A coat was a necessity which became a theological vestment. The alb worn under the chasuble was the typical Greco-Roman undergarment worn by anyone out and about the city. It, too became a theologically founded necessity. The stole worn over or under the chasuble was borrowed from the roman secular government and identified the various officers of the state and how much authority they might have (the traditional theology of the stole suggests that one horizontal stripe meant the priest and two meant the bishop – since stoles are made by non-Catholic suppliers the stripes are less meaningful today). Incense was used to cover up the nasty smells associated with communal living in the good old days when there was a chamber pot in every room, nobody used Secret or Degree and the garbage was more often than not tossed out a convenient window (in Jesus day incense covered up the stink of a rotting body when people came to visit the tomb). Today incense has a rich theological meaning but it was used to make the church smell half-way decent when a crowd of people who didn't bathe all that often came for Mass. The entrance procession used to be a simple walk from the rectory into the church for Mass because there was no vesting room in the Churches of old, but it developed into a grand entrance as the grandeur of the Mass itself grew. The ceremonial washing of the hands during the preparation of gifts (and after the collection, by the way) was a practical necessity because the priest accepted the gifts of the people which were more often than not given “in kind” so he’d have handled cows, chickens, pigs, potatoes, apples, sacks of grain and whatever goods the people provided for the upkeep of the parish. Even after the people began offering coins the washing remained because by then it’d developed its own theological foundations that had very little to do with its very practical origins. The Mass is life so we should realize that it came about from the lives we live, lives which are themselves ritualized so that we’re often accused of doing something “religiously,” like the way we prepare a coffee during morning break or get up in the morning, or even cut the meat served for dinner.

### **The Celebration of Sacraments**

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. **Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
