Dear People of God,

I was recently asked to review some material from the internet and thought I'd respond via my weekly series of letters in order to broaden the audience for the answers. First and foremost a warning: Don't trust everything you find on the internet – unlike learned journals, little of what you find is peer reviewed by admitted experts or even the local bishop (who would give a *nihil* obstat decree to suggest it's authentic Catholic teaching) for accuracy or even honesty. So, first question of five statements I was asked to review (three from popes and two from the bible): Someone showed me a quote from Pope Innocent III (from the early 1200's) which states there is one universal Church of the faithful outside of which no one can be saved. Is that true? Yes and maybe no. Whoever copied that quote or translated it from the original Latin has quoted it way out of context so that you might think it's speaking of the Roman Catholic Church since Innocent was a Roman catholic pope. That's where the "no" might come in, depending on how you read Innocent's quote. It does not refer to our Roman Catholic Church. As a matter of fact, we regularly address this issue in the Creed we recite Sunday after Sunday: I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic church. The universal church (that's what the Greek word catholic means) we believe in is God's church, not ours. It's the community of the faithful God has called and who answered that call wherever it took them. You'll hear this in the Eucharistic prayer when the priest remember also our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection, and all those who have died in your mercy, welcome them into the light of your face. Even the first part of that prayer is broader than the Roman Catholic faith since many other denominations believe in the resurrection. We should always remember that God's will is not the death of a sinner, but his salvation. That means God will save whom God wants to save and while it's our obligation as Roman Catholics to live and invite people to be saved in the Roman Catholic faith, it's not our duty to tell God that outside that Roman Catholic community no one can be saved. That arrogance and pride duplicates the original sin of Adam who thought he knew better - and more - than God! Some of us who are a little more matured in years will remember Father Leonard Feeney, a priest who was cashiered for heresy, who taught that outside the Roman Catholic ecclesial community there was no hope of salvation. He was active around the time I made my First Holy Communion and had guite a few followers who held that same narrow view, some of whom are still around today despite the Roman Catholic Church telling them they're wrong to believe that. Keep in mind that salvation is God's will and God's business, not ours. Innocent's correct that salvation is to be found in the universal church God has instituted among men and women, not in some human-invented quasi faith which has little or nothing to do with God. The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




Stations of the Cross
