Dear People of God,

Over the past couple of weeks the Diocese has introduced a Diocesan Vision and Mission Statement with some very specific goals. It's both an ambitious project and a nostalgic return to the early days of my own Priestly career when Bishop Hoffman rolled out the five-year Mission and Goals process which called on all the parishes to join in the creation of specific parish plans to implement the various goals established by the diocese. Bishop Thomas and the Strategic Planning Teams have focused on what the Diocese can do over the next three years to enhance its ability to serve the parishes and people of our nineteen county region. Their task required several months to consult, pray, think, talk and then hammer out workable and attainable goals. These were presented to the parish via a colorful diagrammatic chart which lays out the Vision, the mission and the "six pillars" or goal areas with the goals of each. I hope you've hung onto that pass-out which was in the bulletin, but if not you can obtain a copy from the office or by downloading it from past editions of the bulletin available on the parish web site. Having it handy is because as part of the rolling out process for the Diocesan Vision and Mission Statement, each parish and institution is being urged to examine its own Vision and Mission statements to make sure they accord as well as possible with that of the Diocese. Toward that end, I will be passing on to the Pastoral Council the task of reviewing our current Vision and Mission Statement as well as implementing a goals process based on the parish Vision and Mission Statement. A diagrammatic chart applying the diocesan format to our own parish and its anticipated needs for growth and ministry is included in this week's bulletin and I ask that you hang on to that as well because it will be the framework for a lot of time and effort over the next months and years to make our parish a more vibrant, involved and active parish. It is my hope, as I would pray is also yours that we begin to seek out and recruit new families and individuals to become part of the Immaculate Conception family. It is essential in these times that active recruitment become part and parcel of any parish whose majority membership is in the "seasoned" demographic that hopes to maintain its existence into the future. You will see in the chart that we will be putting together a door-to-door census which requires developing teams of two or three people who will actually visit every dwelling in our territory to determine where we might encourage fallen away inactive Catholics to come along with us, where we might evangelize the unchurched, and where we can augment our outreach by meeting needs we are not currently aware of. Everyone must help with this as Sir Baden-Powell so often said "Be prepared!"

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
