Dear People of God,

In my examination of five statements by the bible and popes we come to one that is from the gospel of John (17:21): *That they may be one as thou Father art in me and I in thee, that they also may be one in us, that (as a consequence) the world may believe that Thou hast sent me.* The quotation is from the Revised Standard version, a production of the National Council of Churches (USA) and published in a Catholic version in 1966. Of course, John didn't write in English, the old fashioned version here or the newer ones we may hear at Mass, so I'll go back to the Greek original to translate this for you into ordinary 21st century English. To begin, let me mention that the quote is taken out of the context of a much longer discourse by Jesus at the Last Supper. It begins in chapter 14 and runs through the end of chapter 17. Much of it is, as is this short quote, part of a prayer or conversation Jesus is having with the Father on the eve on of his death. It has nothing to do with a specific ecclesial community, Catholic or otherwise, but addresses the will of God that the unity between the person of the the Trinity might be the unity between the people of faith and the God who gives the gift of faith. Jesus prays that Apostles listening to him might understand that integral gift of unity and teach it in their own time and place. So the quote actually begins: *I request not just for these, but for believers through their word of me, that all may be one as you in me and me in you; that they also may be in us that the world may believe that you sent me.* Essentially, Jesus is asking the Father to do him a favor which the Father does not have to do (that's why the word request is used) and reveal the unity among the Trinity and make the Apostles effective teachers. Jesus is only too well aware that after the Ascension he's going home and leaving the future of whatever church the Apostles establish in their hands. His prayer is that they do a good job and base it on the unity which exists in the reality of the Trinity. There is absolutely nothing condemnatory or restive in the words Jesus shares with the Father and which the Apostles heard. There is no blueprint for a church here, but a foundational point for the teaching which a future church ought to be doing. That's why the first two or three centuries saw the foundation of many churches, each independent of all the others and only after much passage of time coming to accept the "first among equals" theory of the papacy. For example, Paul founded churches in Ephesus, Corinth, Thessaly, Colossus, and other towns and cities and never considered them a single church because each had its own needs and issues to deal with. Yes, they all formed the Body of Christ, but that did not, for Paul anyway, mean they all shared a single focused means of attaining salvation. His understanding was that in their unity of faith in the cross of Jesus they found the gateway to salvation; however, he did not condemn the recalcitrant Jews or Gentiles who refused to accept that gift of faith.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
