Dear People of God,

As we continue our way through the Easter Season, I wanted to respond to a question I was asked on the Solemnity of the Annunciation (25 March, the day Mary's simple *yes* precipitated the Incarnation of Jesus the Christ). During Lent, we traditionally omit the Gloria from our Masses and instead of singing the Alleluia before the Gospel, we proclaim *Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory*, or some similar acclamation. On the Annunciation, we happily sing the Gloria but retain the gospel acclamations of Lent. So the question is why do we bring back one but not the other on the solemnity? A corollary question is why do we make the gospel change in the first place? The answer has to do with why we celebrate Lent. For many it's a forty day period of penance performed in a dour, heavy mood of self-sacrifice. For the Church, on the other hand, it's forty days of rejoicing leading up to the celebration of the Triduum – the three days of gladness when we share the table of the Lord, witness the salvation of human kind on the wood of the cross, and stand before the empty tomb proclaiming the wonder of the Resurrection. For the Church, the Lenten observances aren't an opportunity to put on sackcloth and ashes, but to truly do penance as penance is meant to be: to give thanks through specified actions which reveal our faith in the promises of God and our willingness to do something good to show that faith to the world around us - which may explain why all those Friday fish fries are so popular and such happy gatherings of God's people. As I hope we all know, the Mass is principally directed to the Father (through Jesus Christ in the unity of the Holy Spirit). The Alleluia's proclaimed at Mass are also directed to the Father; however, during Lent, as a reminder that it was Jesus the Christ who walked the by-ways of ancient Israel, who taught in synagogue and Temple, who dined with sinners and tax collectors, who cured the sick, who forgave the sins of sinners, who raised the dead to life, who suffered on the cross and rose from the dead, we direct our praise for the Word of God in the Gospels to Jesus. There is no need to replace that proclamation on the Solemnity of the Annunciation and perhaps no single celebration of the Church more deserves to make its prayer of thanksgiving of the Word directly to Jesus than the day he became one with us in the Incarnation. As we now redirect our thanksgiving to the Father we do so in recognition of the Father who, as St. Paul reminds us in the Epistle of Easter Sunday, *raised Jesus from the dead*.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
