Dear People of God,

It seems as if the world is spinning faster than it should – we’re already advancing on the end of the Easter Season and arrival of Pentecost and Ordinary Time. The high holy days which now descend upon us – Ascension, Pentecost, Corpus Christi, Trinity Sunday - remind us that we participate in the actual work of Jesus which brings about salvation. We don’t just recall it through celebrations, but are steeped in the events which brought about the Church we know and love. I’m reminded of an old TV show hosted by a WWII correspondent who later “made good” on CBS – the show was *YOU ARE THERE* and, of course, the host was Walter Cronkite. The premise was to use documentary film to draw the viewer into the actual events being portrayed. It was quite successful and gave rise to a host of documentary platforms many of us are familiar with today: National Geographic, Science Channel, History Channel, and others (I won’t list reality shows because I hope nobody is watching those heavily scripted anything-but-real shows that are largely make-believe). For us Catholics, the symbols we use at Mass or in other sacraments do far more than create a semblance of being there, they take us there – to the Last Supper, to the foot of the Cross, to the mountain of the Ascension, to the upper room where the Holy Spirit descended on all present - and that includes you and me. As St. Paul said, *this is a great mystery*, but it is our faith – we believe that in the person of Jesus Christ all the baptized are brought together to literally be there. That’s why for us the Eucharist is more than a simple thank you to God: it’s the very body and blood Jesus handed around to the Apostles and to you and me as we share in that very same meal. For us, the celebration of Pentecost isn’t a dry re-enactment of a two thousand year old event, it’s you and me being transported to that moment when the Holy Spirit enflamed the faithful to become strident evangelists anxious to race to the rooftops and proclaim salvation in Jesus Christ. Our Jewish sisters and brothers also see this same participatory sense of involvement when they proclaim the texts of the Old Testament. It was an ancient understanding in the time of Jesus which he chose to hand on to us in the Christian movement so should be seen by us Catholics as another of those bonds which tie us so inexorably to the People of the Covenant. It’s also one of the “recruiting tools” which we ought to be using to invite others to come along on our Catholic journey of faith and begins with the simple question: Don’t you want to be there with Jesus as He accomplishes salvation?

### *The Celebration of Sacraments*

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
