Dear People of God,

Not only have we arrived at the end of the Easter Season but we're now just about half way through the calendar year! Where has the time gone? In fact, the Solemnity of the Ascension should remind us that time will, in the end, be gone. Just as Jesus' time on earth came to its conclusion, so, too, will ours. In his final words to his disciples, Jesus has some advice about how to prepare for when our personal clock runs down: keep active! I'm sure every health care professional in the parish will agree that keeping active will improve quality of life and the amount of time we have to enjoy it, but Jesus means we should all remain spiritually about the business of proclaiming the Good News; first around the house, then in the community, and eventually in all the world. That proclamation isn't necessarily done with words although they can be particularly helpful in some situations. Rather, Jesus asks that we be a people who serve the needs of others. Acts of kindness do more to proclaim our faith than words might. Actions have an immediate effect while words may not bring about understanding for some time, as those words percolate through the mind of the listener. For example, if we feed the hungry, they notice right away that life has improved. If we give drink to the thirsty, the recipient feels better immediately. If we clothe the naked, the person can feel warmth embrace them as quickly as they put on the coat or jacket. That's how we can best proclaim: to the family at home *via* the ordinary care-giving provided for spouse and children; in the community around us through Outreach or some other worthwhile charity; and across the globe by our support of any number of programs, including the ACA, which helps fund Diocesan missions programs. Thanks to all who made an ACA pledge! Once again the parish is near the top in its efforts to assist in the larger works of the Diocese ! And while I'm at it, a "how about lending a hand?" to those who have not as yet made a pledge. You can become an active disciple working across the face of the earth with your kind donation. Speaking of world-wide action, many years ago, I sponsored "a child in poverty" like the ads on radio say. I'm on my fifth one now, the others have all grown up, one was killed in a civil war, and my sponsored child is a cute little girl in the poorest part of India. I get an occasional letter which reminds me that actions make a world of difference!

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

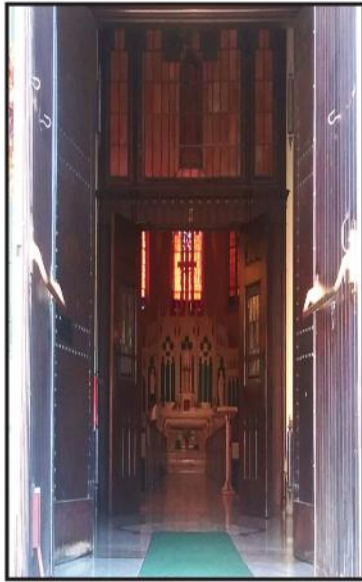
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
