Dear People of God,

Ah, summer time – a chance for some of us to slow down, get away and relax from the ordinary expectations of our busy lives. Bar-b-que scents the air, the joyous sounds of children enjoying the pool or splash pad assault our ears. And the roar of cars, vans, trucks and RV's heading off for a well-earned vacation remind us that our pews will be a little emptier than usual. Certainly taking time off is a God-like behavior. God rested on the seventh day of creation and expects us, in imitation, to do likewise. Finding the time to pause from our daily labors is a necessary aspect of life and of good health: physical and mental! It should also be a way to energize our spiritual selves. I'm always delighted to have parishioners returning from a trip out of town stop to comment on Mass elsewhere, or give me a copy of the bulletin, almost always pointing out the weekly income figures. I'm also always delighted when a mysterious envelope shows up in the mail from some far flung corner of the world and inside is a parishioner's weekly offering envelope. Every parish counts on the regular generosity of its parishioners to make sure the lights are on, the sound system is fired up, the front steps are swept and on and on and on. When vacation season hits all too often so does the Sunday collection take a serious hit. Yet many of those who are vacationing continue to think of their home parish and its mission so take along their envelopes and drop them into the local basket. Wherever we go we can find the faithful and become part of another family of faith, if only for a brief celebration on a Sunday morning. Our faith invigorates that of others and we are in turn enlivened and our own faith fortified. We become missionaries who share the Good News simply by being there, faces of visitors who can be welcomed in the Name of Jesus the Lord. Enjoy some free time this summer and allow the Spirit to fill you with energy, exuberance, and delight in the marvels God has placed all around us. The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

CCD classes for sacramental preparation for our public school children will not be offered by Historic St. Patrick's anymore. First Communion and First Penance would be offered to those in 2nd grade and older who have not received those Sacraments. 
