Dear People of God,

It is right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord God, Almighty Father.

You'll no doubt recognize (I hope) today's introductory phrase. It's the introduction to the many prefaces for the Eucharist Prayers we use at Mass. I've used the bold after reading the comics and perusing the latest morality tale going on in Mary Worth. Today's introduction is a reminder that the first order of business among Christians is a spirt of gratitude. This is so vital an aspect of being a Christian that the title given to our principal celebration is derived from the same root word, a Greek term Eucharistia, the Eucharist. Just as our Mass is a prayer-filled thanksgiving to God for the many gifts poured out into our lives (life itself, good health – at least for the younger crowd – a job, house, talent to do some worthwhile work, a voice to sing out our praise of God or just entertain the neighbors while showering), so, too, should our behavior, whether alone or among others, reflect a spirt of continual thanksgiving. Unfortunately, we now live in a culture which has little place for genuine gratitude, so we often encounter those who find fault with everything, blame everyone for whatever it is that person is unhappy about, and who wag their fingers in accusation when others fall short of that person's personal expectations. Such behaviors have no place in our lives, let alone in our worship space, if we claim to be Christian. In fact, if you skim through the Sermon on the Mount, in chapters 5-7, you'll find Jesus' commentary on the Big Ten and much of what he has to say reflects this same spirit of gratitude; gratitude for our lives, our families, our friends, our neighbors, our fellow worshippers. A gratitude which leads to forbearance, understanding, tolerance, forgiveness and peace. A spirit of gratitude is behind that famous section of 1 Corinthians where St. Paul is commenting on the three Cardinal virtues: Faith, Hope and Love. Faith opens our eyes to the goodness of God for which we give thanks, hope opens our hearts to the future so that we do our best to assist others in getting into Heaven, and love which undergirds all our actions in sacrificial service of others. In essence, then, gratitude is a way of life, a blueprint for how we ought to conduct ourselves every hour of every day. It means being thankful for what we have instead of resentful and angry over what we don't have. Yes, it means putting up with the shenanigans of those who lack a spirit of gratitude but we'll never bring about the conversion of the ingrate (a word derived from the same source as gratitude) if we don't practice gratitude ourselves. Perhaps what we need is a new campaign featuring one of those wrist band except instead of WWJD it's boldly proclaim WDWJD: We Do What Jesus Does. Jesus always and everywhere gave thanks to his Father and so should we.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




