Dear People of God,

Last week I wrote a brief review of gratitude and after Mass I discovered how many people read the bulletin during Mass because several stopped me with some questions about gratitude. Here's one I'd like to expand upon for everyone: *What does always and everywhere giving thanks to God have to do with anyone else, can't I be grateful just to God?* The answer to that is you can't be grateful to God unless you show gratitude for and toward what God has given you. God is the source of everything around us, from the sun that rises every day (even if the recent rains have obscured it from direct sight), to the groceries we find on the store shelves, to the invention of those who bring us self-steering cars, to the neighbor's cat that keeps us up all night serenading his lady friend, to the fermentation process that allows us to enjoy an adult beverage at Mud Hens games, to the talent of the soloist leading us in the Psalm, to the maintenance people who keep the campus spic and span, to the liturgical decorators and decorations which enhance our worship space, to the men and women who came before us and left such beautiful surroundings for our celebrations, to those men and women who will come after us and to whom we should show gratitude by leaving them equally beautiful spaces for their celebrations. Gratitude as a way of life suggests that we get along with others, praise others for their accomplishments, assist others in their sufferings, aid others in their conversion because each person we encounter is in the image and likeness of the God to whom we should always and everywhere be giving thanks. In a more practical sense, it's hard to be grateful to someone while trashing what they've given us!

So then, do we show genuine gratitude and now and again actually *say* (and mean) thank you to the checkout person at the grocery? Do we now and then stop to say thank you to the greeters who welcome us to Mass? Do we pause to give thanks for the mechanic who tuned up the car? Do we take time to speak our thanks to the server at the restaurant, even if (s)he's really busy and doesn't meet our expectations for coffee refills? Do we thank doctors and dentists for their expertise in keeping us healthy? Do we ever say thank you to those who provide age-appropriate liturgy of the Word for our children? When we say those many different thank you's our gratitude is being given equally to God.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

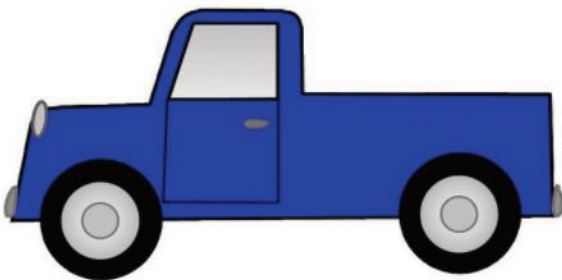
