Dear People of God,

My letters about gratitude have touched a chord and I've received several e-mails. Most of the messages commenting on instances of poor or missing gratitude right here in the parish. Unfortunately, I, too, have seen glaring examples of a lack of gratitude, most of them the results of the enculturation of contemporary Americana into the lives of Christians. Real gratitude can only blossom where there is a genuine sense of participation in a community of like-minded individuals willing to collaborate and the recognition that no one is above that community. Today, America has become a highly individualized nation in which the self is superior to all others. It's a *me first* society in which self-centered men and women pursue their wants at the expense of others. This leads to some of the disastrous consequences we can see all around us: Teen suicide is skyrocketing because teens, who really do have to be immersed in a social setting, are more and more isolated by their phones and tablets and find they cannot deal with that isolation; intruder attacks are on the increase because people quite literally are a law unto themselves; road rage is common because drivers presume the road is their personal and private corridor. This same kind of individualistic attitude can erode a parish's life by criticizing rather than affirming, by attacking rather than joining, by silence rather than words of encouragement and support. When we complain without offering to do something positive, we are not showing gratitude; rather we are harming the body of Christ. That doesn't mean that criticism and complaining are off limits, but when we come forward with a complaint we should have in mind some way we can participate in creating the appropriate actions and behaviors which alleviate the problem. In other words, when we complain that the sidewalk needs sweeping after a late Saturday storm, have the broom ready to help do the sweeping instead of simply saying what everyone already knows: the maintenance personnel don't work Sundays. Gratitude, then, isn't just words of thanks; it's actions which reveal that we are, in fact, thankful. If we watch closely we can see such behaviors: the young teen who offers to help an elderly person load groceries into the car, the person behind the harried mother with a squalling infant and three other highly active children who offers to keep an eye on the three while Mom deals with the wet diaper, the neighbor who pulls the garbage cans to the curb, the person on the bus who gets up for someone else to sit, the volunteer who visits the nursing home to read the newspapers for the residents, and a lot of other examples any of us can think of. A good daily reflection we should all take up is to pause from our busy lives and consider what words of thanks we've offered to God, whether directly or though his creation, and what actions have we taken which reveal that we always and everywhere give thanks to God.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Keep us open to our need of Your love and fellowship. Help us to work together to serve You and each other for the good of the Church, for the people of our Parish and for Your greater glory.


