Dear People of God,

Before I depart from the topic of gratitude - our thankfulness demonstrated by forbearance and action - I want to respond to one other question I received regarding gratitude. The questioner asked *why should I act with gratitude when nobody is grateful for what I do?* My immediate response is that one shouldn't be concerned about the response, but be concerned about your own actions of thankfulness. One of the significant obligations of the committed Christian is to act like Christ. That means we should proclaim a year of favor from the Lord, teach others the way of the Lord, bring about healing and reconciliation, and turn the other cheek when someone offends. All of that means we are to be witnesses to our faith in God, our hope for eternal life and our love of all that God has given us, even those he's given us who act in ways God never intended and who offend! It's by witness (what we do) that we bring about understanding, from understanding comes conversion, and from conversion comes an openness to the same faith we espouse. I'm sure that one or two of those reading this will recall my having urged all of us to invite others to come along on our pilgrimage to the Kingdom by inviting them to be part of the RCIA. The best way to offer that invitation isn't by twisting arms, bribing them with fresh baked cookies, or even by telling them your own faith story, but by witnessing to others our own love of God and God's creation, especially God's people who bear his image and likeness. Witness means treating the world around us as if it were a priceless gift (because it is), treating the people around us as if each one were Christ in our midst (because each person is in the image and likeness of God). Acting that way, grateful for the people around us, provides all we need to do in order to invite others to come along with us. Our compassion, understanding, kindness, and caring speak much louder than words because actions have a direct effect on people. These kinds of behavior make others feel comfortable and open them to a response in goodness. So in the end, gratitude is not only a way of life each of us ought to follow, but it's life giving. Our world very much needs a greater demonstration of gratitude. I invite all of those reading this to give it serious thought and adopt gratitude as an ordinary way of dealing with the world around you. You'll be surprised at how much better you feel about yourself and the world and how much better you get along with those you encounter.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

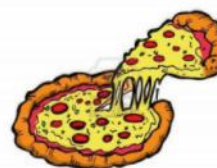
