Dear People of God,

Thanks be to God!

We may think that's the end of the Mass, but it's really just the beginning. For the committed Catholic, the Mass is both source and summit. When we come to the end of a Sunday celebration, we're actually beginning preparation for the next time we encounter Jesus in the same celebration of Word and Sacrament. That means that the thanks we proclaim at the 'end' of Mass isn't just for the good things God did or will do "in the real world," but for the mysteries with which God will bless us in the sacramental life of the Church. *Thanks be to God* for the waters of Baptism which washed away our sins and opened the way to salvation in Jesus Christ. Baptism didn't just happen "back in the day", but accompanies us every hour of every day in the real presence of the Holy Spirit making us a 24-7 Temple of that same Holy Spirit. God doesn't walk away and leave us on our own following the rituals associated with Baptism but remains in us, with us, guiding us, and accompanying us wherever we go and in whatever we do. Gratitude for that real presence is meant to soften the edges cut into us by sin, be it the original sin with which we were born as children of Adam and Eve, or the subsequent sinfulness which seems to ensnare us all in its web. In gratitude, we find good things to say of and to others even if there's a temptation to say something negative or degrading. *Thanks be to God* for the Seven Gifts and numerous Fruits of the Holy Spirit. These gifts and fruits aren't anything new to our human condition, but as we embrace them in the Sacrament of Confirmation they take on a different context and coloration. Wisdom, Understanding and Knowledge, when seen through the lens of gratitude, offer each of us a rare opportunity to sense the correctness of both thanksgiving and compassion toward others and offer that gift generously and regularly. Fortitude, Piety, and Fear of the Lord temper what we know so that we can reach out to others with kindness and care. Counsel provides a kind of seal on our words so that, as we give thanks to God for the dignity of others, we say words which impart goodness and concern rather than negativity and hurt. *Thanks be to God* for the nourishment received in the Eucharist. Gratitude helps us look beyond the simplicity of bread and wine and truly see the real presence of Jesus the Christ and to take that real presence into our being for the continual perfection of a way of life steeped in Jesus himself. Sacramental gratitude awakens us to the dignity of all the others sharing that same Body and Blood, creating a unity which rises above any perceived or even real difference. We are truly one and act that way in word and deed as we share our spiritual journey here in the parish.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

A New Look for Our Deacons:
Effective August 10, 2019, the Feast of St. Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr, Bishop Thomas has given permission to the deacons of the Diocese of Toledo, if they so choose, to wear a gray clerical shirt when they are exercising their diaconal ministry in the diocese. The Bishop’s permission comes in response to a recommendation made by the diocesan Deacon Council. The permission to wear clerical attire in ministerial settings, if the deacon so chooses, is meant to assist the deacon as a visible sign of his ministry of service and to help the faithful recognize the role of deacons in the life of the Church. Deacons are members of the Catholic clergy. The wearing of the gray clerical shirt is strictly optional on the part of the deacon.
