Dear People of God,

Thanks be to God!

Yes, those are our words, loudly (I would hope) and proudly exclaimed as we prepare to leave Mass and take on the world in the name of Jesus Christ. That simple phrase of gratitude is, however, more than just four brief words strung together. They are a focusing belief in the divine and in the relationship between the divine and ourselves, an admission of our inferiority to the superiority of God in all things. They are also a focusing device on the relationship we ought to have toward the others who are exclaiming those same thanks to the same God. That means we are giving thanks to God for people, many of whom we can see and hear around us. Gratitude is extended, or should be, to those who took time through the week to clean, dust, mop, launder and undertake all the other activities which prepare the worship space for our weekly visit. Do we know who they are? Have we ever said “thanks?” Gratitude is extended, or should be, to those who have offered their time and talent to the numerous ministers required to celebrate mass well: ushers/greeters, servers, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, musicians, choir, offertory collectors and presenters, hospitality providers, and often others when there’s a special celebration. Do we know who these people are? Do we bother to actually say “thanks?” Gratitude is extended, or should be, to the many men, women and children who regularly contribute from their income to support the ministries of the parish. Do we ever stop any of them to say “thanks?” Gratitude is extended, or should be, to those who maintain the works of the parish throughout the week, secretaries, office managers, filing personnel, maintenance personnel, and outreach volunteers. Do we know who these people are? Do we ever stop to say “thanks?” It’s easy to forget gratitude and make a quick judgmental and negative remark when any of those who assure that we have a celebration don’t live up to our personal standards or expectations and I hear often enough from various volunteers and staff that such remarks are being made. I wonder if we ought to instead show a sense of gratitude that builds up rather than express our dissatisfactions which can only tear down. A lack of gratitude and the ensuing rush to judgment often leads to people leaving the parish, some because they don’t seem to be getting their way, others because they are belittled and demeaned by the very people whose task as Christians is to build up. I would invite everyone to seriously consider being positive whether you want to or not, especially when you don’t want. That means more than just biting a tongue to prevent some snide or cutting remark from bursting out of your mouth, but stepping up where you perceive something is wrong to volunteer to make it right. It means that instead of complaining, you volunteer to assist to make sure things are done properly, not necessarily the way you think they should be. Gratitude isn’t just saying thank you, it’s doing the things that merit thanks.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

A New Look for Our Deacons:

Effective August 10, 2019, the Feast of St. Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr, Bishop Thomas has given permission to the deacons of the Diocese of Toledo, if they so choose, to wear a gray clerical shirt when they are exercising their diaconal ministry in the diocese. The Bishop's permission comes in response to a recommendation made by the diocesan Deacon Council. The permission to wear clerical attire in ministerial settings, if the deacon so chooses, is meant to assist the deacon as a visible sign of his ministry of service and to help the faithful recognize the role of deacons in the life of the Church. Deacons are members of the Catholic clergy. The wearing of the gray clerical shirt is strictly optional on the part of the deacon.
