Dear People of God,

Thanks be to God!

I want to close out my series on gratitude with a couple of stories, both true, and hopefully nothing like them has ever happened in the parish here.

A parish volunteer had given ten to fifteen hours a week to her ministry over a period of a decade, more often than not to the noisy complaints of fellow parishioners who were quick to point out each and everything "wrong" the woman did in stocking, passing out goods, and working with the clients at the food pantry. Much of the complaining occurred "behind her back", but she heard about it. She didn't let the complaints stop her because there were no other volunteers to do the work she did for nearly a decade. She died of an unexpected heart attack, and there was the typical wake service at the funeral home a block or two from the church, where she would be feted in the funeral rites. Hundreds of people, clients of the pantry and parishioners came by the wake, waited on the street to get in and loudly lamented that the pantry would likely now close because "the saint" had died, although by that time no less than fifteen volunteers had surfaced to pick up the load. While she lived, she never heard the laudatory statements of those who were at the wake and never had the blessing of knowing there were others who would continue the ministry. How sad that this marvelous woman died without knowing the gratitude of others.

A priest labored in a large, fairly well-to-do parish, constantly barraged by a few people about his perceived failings, poor leadership, long homilies, and inappropriate stewardship of parish monies to the point that he was seeing a counselor for depression. It seemed a day couldn't go by that one or another, often two or three, of these nay-sayers found opportunity to "let Father have it!" After about four years of this, he asked for a transfer and prepared to go on to another assignment in a bigger, busier parish where the Bishop informed him his many talents could be put to good use. The parish staff put together a farewell celebration with a pot-luck dinner, performances by the school children, a musical program by a couple of high school students, and presentation of a beautiful chasuble. Hundreds of parishioners showed up, dropped envelopes with cash gifts into a basket, laughed, and enjoyed a great time, and as they were leaving, praised and thanked the priest for his efforts in the parish. After everyone was gone and the priest was helping with the cleanup, he seemed distraught and when asked about it he replied: "where were they all these years past?" Where were those who weekly, many even daily, proclaimed *Thanks be to God* but never bothered to say thanks to God's representative in their midst.

It is right and just, our duty and our obligation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Almighty God.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



A New Look for Our Deacons:

Effective August 10, 2019, the Feast of St. Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr, Bishop Thomas has given permission to the deacons of the Diocese of Toledo, if they so choose, to wear a gray clerical shirt when they are exercising their diaconal ministry in the diocese. The Bishop's permission comes in response to a recommendation made by the diocesan Deacon Council. The permission to wear clerical attire in ministerial settings, if the deacon so chooses, is meant to assist the deacon as a visible sign of his ministry of service and to help the faithful recognize the role of deacons in the life of the Church. Deacons are members of the Catholic clergy. The wearing of the gray clerical shirt is strictly optional on the part of the deacon.
