Dear People of God,

“So,” the question goes, “what is this stream of consciousness, anyway?” For starters, it’s that little voice in our heads that allows us to cull from the vast memory bank stored away in our brain those things that interest us, focus our attention, or help respond to some external impetus. It’s generally a little chaotic because particular ideas, memories, or stimuli will usually call up a specific item for our attention but it’s connected by time and experience to a whole lot more that may interfere with clear thinking. Interruptions in thought can be terribly distracting, like watching the road and a sign on the side sparks a stream of consciousness thought process that distracts us from the big truck right in front of us! It’s why your teacher told you to review what you write and edit as needed to get to the point, without straying all over the map. It’s why conversation tends to be disjointed and leap from idea to idea with very little connective tissue to hold things together. If I were to write about stream of consciousness from stream of consciousness it would come across as poorly planned, poorly developed, and poorly presented (you can see this when a politician or priest ad libs). It may make perfect sense to the person whose stream it is but likely would seem like nonsense to anyone else because we all have a unique set of memories from which that stream is formed. Meditation, a classic Christian ideal, seeks to train the stream of consciousness to focus better on a single thought or memory, for example, the mystery of the Eucharist. Just mentioning that focal point should have sparked a host of thoughts in your mind; perhaps the last time you went to Mass, the bawling baby two pews over, the sweat from a warm summer morning, the way you tripped over too-long trousers as you made your way for First Eucharist, the priest who seemed pretty rushed in administering the Eucharist at that other parish, the little kid who did her bow three people before getting to the sacrament itself, the way the host stuck to the top of your mouth that one time, the fruit fly buzzing around the Precious Blood, the bad note of the person behind you singing the Communion Hymn and on and on. Christian meditation - and it takes a long time and lots of effort to get there - would allow you to focus on *Jesus the Christ, human and divine, body and soul, flesh and blood handed to me as gift*. And nothing else getting in the way, not the weather, not the other people, not the plans we made with Uncle Harvey for breakfast after Mass. Nothing at all interferes. Christian meditation is nothing less than undistracted thinking. Give it a try; it can be very enlightening.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
