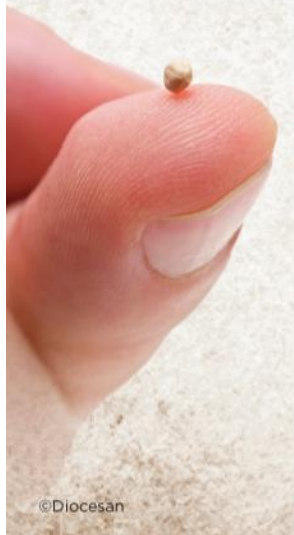

Dear People of God,

With Labor Day comes the social advent of autumn even if the calendar says it occurs on the 21st. Over the years September has become a sort of “New Year’s” for the Church, probably because so many parishes had schools which returned for classes that month. Many parish programs tend to go into estivation (that’s hibernation but done over the summer months) once June arrives and restart in the fall. Bible Study, intense invitations to come for a retreat at the many diocesan retreat centers, children’s liturgy of the Word, and a host of other options and opportunities for spiritual growth, educational enrichment, and more. As Christians, we’re all called to immerse ourselves in these programs. With the variety offered by the parish, the diocese, and other places nearby there is something for everybody even if it’s only coming along for Pints with the Pastor the first Wednesday of the month (and by the way Pints doesn’t take the summer off like many other programs). We publish a list of programs being offered by Lourdes College, the various religious orders, the retreat houses in our area, and as far distant as St. Meinrad (near Louisville, Kentucky). All the priests, deacons, and vowed religious of the diocese are required to take time to make time for a retreat. It’s a good idea for all of us to consider time away from the distractions of the world, our workplace, the television, and cell phone and spend some quality time with the Lord via a retreat master presenting on some topic of interest. I prefer themes which dive into some book of the Bible so I can enhance my knowledge of the Word, hopefully helping me to be a better preacher and teacher by opening myself to the movement of the Spirit through the days spent in retreat. All of us can become better at what God has called us to do, from being a better spouse to a better parent, a better worker and friend. I’m not sure a retreat experience would help with the golf game but it does sharpen the soul to better hear the Spirit of God calling us to the daily tasks of loving God and our neighbor. I’m sure all of us know the need for a more loving, compassionate community so give a retreat a thought and a chance this year. You can find schedules and topics at the web sites of the houses in our diocese (Carey, Fremont, Tiffin) and by glancing at the web pages for Manresa up in Detroit, Bergamo in Dayton and the Jesuit renewal center at Milford. My mother liked Milford and went there often enough to become good friends with Cardinal Bernardin’s mother – they used to boast about their sons, at least one of whom made good! Try a retreat and discover how quickly the Spirit opens your soul to the love of our God.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
