Dear People of God,

As we continue to celebrate the Christmas season (I hope you haven't tossed out all the Christmas decorations yet – we have a ways to go), we should keep in mind that it is far more than just December 25. For the Church, Christ's birth is so important that it takes a whole week to do the celebrating properly – a period of eight days (called an octave). We celebrate the woman whose simple "yes" to the angelic messenger began the process of Jesus' life among us. We pause to consider that this innocent baby came to restore innocence and give us a world of peace. We make note of the dignity and blessing of family by honoring the Holy Family. And we recall our own pilgrimage to the Kingdom by celebrating the pilgrimage of those three wise people who showed up in Jerusalem looking for the King of Israel. It makes for an action-packed season of events and commemorations which I hope attracts us all to a richer sense of the scope of what Jesus' birth is all about.

Epiphany, the celebration of the three wise ones, is actually a word that means revelation. When the three come to Jesus' home, they reveal a lot. First, the *decision* to go looking, the search for the truth hinted at in the universe around us (the star). Second, the *sacrifice* necessary to find the truth (the long journey) since it isn't just going to plop into our hands. Third, the *investment* made to obtain the fruits of knowing the truth (the famous gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh). Fourth, the *discovery* that the truth may not be what we expected (finding a new born king in a stable?). Fifth, the *realization* that God is present in the person of Jesus. This same process of discernment forms the pilgrim way through what remains of the liturgical year. May the Holy Spirit fill you with the wisdom! Do head out on your own pilgrimage of faith so that as this year progresses you might discover the beauty and wonder of a world in which Jesus and you make a big difference.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. **Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.





# **Snow Emergency**

Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses.

Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in the geographic area are also cancelled.
