Dear People of God,

This Tuesday the world celebrates St. Patrick, patron of Ireland and all the Irish and Irish-at-heart. For many it has become an opportunity to dye streets, rivers, and beer emerald green, to march in colorful parades and to visit the closest pub. However, there's more to St. Patrick than a pint of the barkeep's finest.

Although born to a well-to-do family in Wales, Patrick was kidnapped, became a slave, and from that point on until his death, he lived on the edge of poverty. His fame all across Ireland might have led to numerous honors and riches, but he disdained all of that so that he could, as Pope Francis has urged us in the modern era, be one with the poorest of the poor.

Immaculate Conception was established sometime between 1864 and 1865 as a mission chapel of nearby St. Patrick's (although back then the mile's distance was through a swamp and across the Ottawa River). The mission was established through the patronage of the Irish parish when her founder, Edward Anthony Hannin, grew up, was baptized, and attended the Catholic school. Although founded as an Irish national parish, today Immaculate Conception Is a diverse community of families who continue to offer praise, adoration and worship to the loving God Patrick proclaimed 1500 years ago.

In many ways Immaculate Conception emulates the life style of St. Patrick; over the years she has more often than not struggled financially to keep on keeping on. We should be proud of our heritage, proud of our persistence, proud of our diversity, and proud of our faith. One way to show our thanks to God is to actively invite others to join our faith community and to take the pilgrim path to heaven with us. It's not just an opportunity to bring about growth; it's an obligation of our baptismal ministry.

## The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.





Due to the potential spreading of Coronavirus/COVID-19 and influenza, the Diocese of Toledo strongly encourages initiating the following procedures until further notice.

\*Everyone should be strongly encouraged to remain at home when seriously ill. In this instance, the faithful should be encouraged to view or listen to a broadcast of Mass and to make a spiritual communion.

\*The invitation to the sign of peace, although a regular part of our liturgical practice, is always an option. Priest celebrants and deacons are strongly encouraged to exercise the option, provided in the Roman Missal, not to extend the invitation, "Let us offer each other the sign of peace".

\*Priest celebrants are strongly encouraged to exercise the option, provided in the Roman Missal, to refrain from the distribution of the Precious Blood to the faithful and to distribute Holy Communion under one species (the Sacred Host).

\*Kindly note that the faithful should be strongly discouraged from holding hands during the Lord's Prayer, a gesture that is not prescribed in the Roman Missal.

Handwashing is the most effective way to prevent the spreading of germs.
