Dear People of God,

Faith and Begorra, it's that time of year when we celebrate St. Patrick and the parish with the annual Reverse Raffle. This year, due to the continuing threat of the pandemic, the Raffle has been postponed to a later time when we can openly gather for the festivities and excitement associated with the event. As I'm sure everyone knows, the Reverse raffle is the largest single fundraising event held by the parish during the fiscal year and the welfare of the parish relies on the income derived from ticket sales, side-boards, silent auctions, and other attractions. This year is no different in that the needs for which the raffle are intended have not gone by the wayside during the pandemic. The parish is facing the largest outlay for heat and electricity of the season, snow removal has taxed the budget, and all the usual bills are still there as well.

It's nothing new for the parish to face less income than our anticipated outgo; over the century and a half we've been here, all too often the bills mount up while income lags, yet there has never been a time when the people of the parish did not "come through" to literally save the day and the parish. I'm counting on your kindness and generosity to do the same today when we face significant bills and reduced Sunday offerings.

I realize that all of us are facing bills at home and these may well be putting a lot of pressure on each household; however, with all of us being part of the family of God here at Immaculate Conception, may I urge you to please pray about and consider a one-time additional offering to make up for the loss we're experiencing due to the delayed Raffle. Because the timing of the Raffle will put the income we receive into the next fiscal year and apply it to the budget we've put together for that period, we really need to look at this year's income and expenses to balance the books, meet our obligations to our creditors, and provide a safe, warm place for worship. Any amount you can give will help and I'm sure that whatever you can do will be generously replaced by God who cannot be outdone in generosity.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




