Dear People of God,

³² (After the dinner) they went to a place called Gethsemane, and Jesus said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray." ³³ He took Peter, James, and John along with him, and he began to be deeply distressed and troubled. ³⁴ "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death," he said to them. "Stay here and keep watch."

³⁵ Going a little farther, he fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him. ³⁶ "Abba, Father," he said, "everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

³⁷ Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping. "Simon," he said to Peter, "are you asleep? Couldn't you keep watch for one hour?"

The above quote is from the Passion account according to Mark which we heard proclaimed on Palm Sunday. It comes to mind after traveling to Archbold with some parishioners to take part in the Tenebrae Service following a delightful sharing of hospitality and friendship at *The Barn* restaurant. Just as in the gospel, there were twelve faithful who followed the summons of the Lord to come and pray but not quite for an hour (I looked at my wristwatch and saw that the entire service had taken only 50 minutes) and despite the gathering darkness in the church, I don't believe anyone fell asleep! The a cappella choir consisted of individuals from across the diocese and even Michigan, Defiance, Toledo, Bellevue, Maumee, and Lambertville. They did an outstanding job!

Tenebrae is an ancient adaptation of the Liturgy of the Hours for the morning prayer of Good Friday. At some point in history, it was transferred to Wednesday of Holy Week to serve as an introduction to the events of the Triduum: the Supper of the Lord on Thursday, the Passion of the Cross on Good Friday, and the Vigil of the Resurrection on Saturday. It is focused by the *Lamentations of the Prophet Jeremiah* (You can find them in your Bible or look them up on the FORMED platform or YouTube for some insight into what they're about) and concludes with the moving polyphony of the Benedictus (Zechariah's song at the birth of John the Baptist in Luke's Gospel). It was a popular service in the era of Msgr. Sawkins and the Tenebrae candelabra is still in the attic of the church, a prized memento of the storied past of the parish and the Church. The Cathedral here in Toledo usually celebrates Tenebrae but because it draws a standing room only crowd, it was necessarily cancelled this year.

My thanks to the disciples who, like the Twelve two millennia ago, spent an hour praying with the Lord. It will surely redound to the blessing of the entire parish.

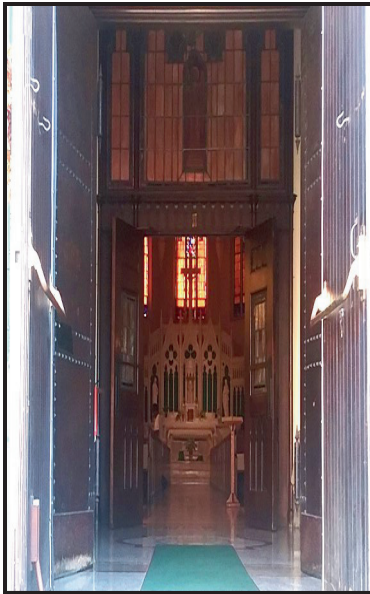

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

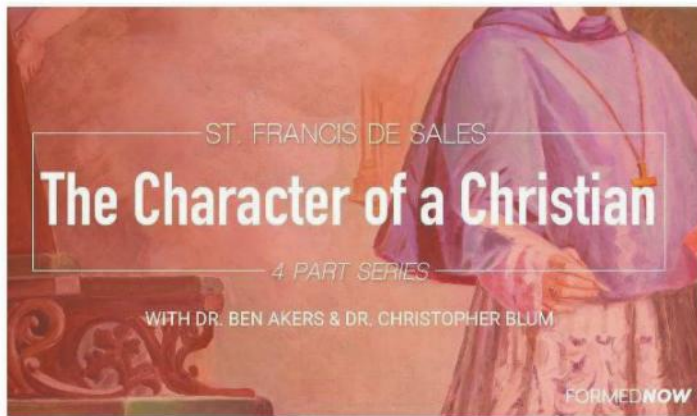
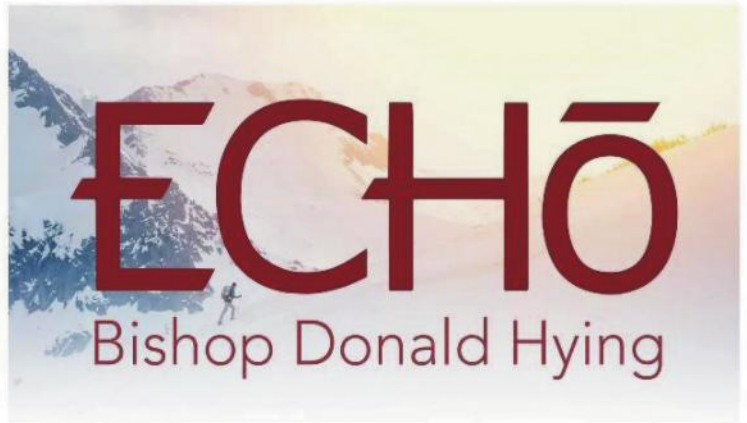

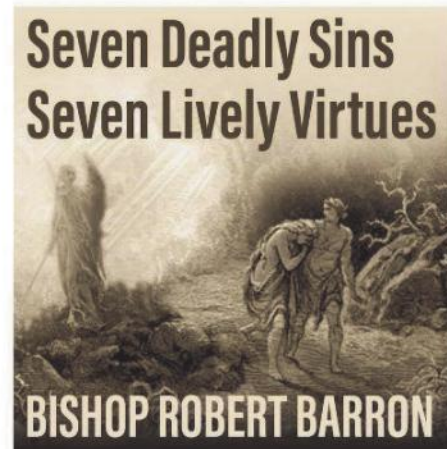
