Dear People of God,



With the Resurrection still on our minds I'd like to offer this pictorial representation of the moment of the Christ's rising from the dead. It's from a Byzantine church in Turkey built around 1050 and illustrated in *Resurrecting Easter* by John Dominic and Sarah Sexton Crossan (copyright 2018 by the authors, p 15). Crossan is one of the world's foremost scripture scholars and has written numerous books, including on the meaning of the parables, an area in which I had the opportunity to attend a couple of lectures by the author.

Resurrecting Easter was an excellent read made part of my Easter Season spiritual growth thanks to someone who passed the book on to me. Full

of illustrations well worth your own discovery, the photo reproduced here is an attempt by the iconographer to capture the exact moment of Jesus' rising from the dead, or returning from the hell we mention in the Apostles' Creed. In Greek around the edge are the names of those "being pulled from their sepulchers (p. 16)" from the underworld by Jesus: Adam and Eve and behind them "the To the left of Jesus are Kings David and Solomon together with a few other representative saints just visible as haloes behind them. And below, in the dark area which designates the land of the dead (hell) is Hades, guardian of the dead who is being held down by Jesus' cross. Beside Hades (identified as such in the descriptive panels outside the church in four different languages) are shattered doors, bolts, and locks suggesting that Jesus has conquered death; death no longer has meaning, and in Jesus' rising all rise, symbolized by Adam, Eve, and the others. The fresco conveys the resurrection of the dead from the very beginning of time as the fruit of Jesus' death on the Cross. It conveys the triumph of the Cross over the underworld where the dead have been held captive awaiting this wondrous moment when Jesus himself liberates the dead and literally takes them along into the resurrection. In the Latin Church, to which we belong, our images of the Resurrection have lost this larger sense of what is occurring when Jesus exits the tomb. I hope this brief glimpse helps to make sense of the Apostles' Creed and what is signified by Jesus' descent into hell and what a powerful event that was for each of us who await our own liberation from death and rising to the promised glory of Jesus' Kingdom in its fullness.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
