Dear People of God,

The Diocese of Toledo will soon be inviting us to enter into a parish, deanery, and regional *Intentional Planning* process to plot out the future of the parish, the deanery, and the region. All too often we get caught up in the immediate needs of parish and community and consequently get caught when the future arrives with demanding and unavoidable consequences. *Intentional Planning* hopes to give the opportunity to face the present and the future in positive and constructive ways.

Perhaps the best way to begin *Intentional Planning* is to assess who we are as a parish. We might accomplish this by returning to the tried and true elements: who, what, why, when, where and how. The *who* is the demographic analysis of parish membership, the *what* is the scope of parish ministry, the *why* is a spiritual connection of programs and participants to the overarching work of Jesus Christ, the *when* is organized around a calendar, the *where* examines the campus and its extension into the surrounding community and the *how* looks at the variety of ways the parish accomplishes its goals, ministries and even its dreams.

Intentional Planning goes beyond the parish to consider the broader aspect of mission and ministry in the deanery to analyze its real needs, the real capacity to provide for them and any duplication of efforts that could better and more economically be performed through collaboration and cooperation. Our deanery is the inner city of Toledo and consists of Rosary Cathedral, Immaculate Conception, the Padua Center, Sts. Adalbert and Hedwig, St. Charles, St. Francis DeSales Outreach, St. Hyacinth, St. Joseph, St. Martin de Porres, St. Patrick, and Sts. Peter and Paul. A secondary phase will ask two or three deaneries to do a joint analysis. This aspect of Intentional Planning offers an opportunity to consider each parish or institution as part of the larger diocese and its mission and ministry.

Intentional Planning also expands the consideration of the who, what, when, where and how to the areas adjacent to the deanery to assess how best to meet the needs of both Catholics and those who are being served in the area via collaborative programming and ministries.

Of course, *Intentional Planning* also considers a few other important factors in moving into the future. These include recruiting new members by advancing the RCIA efforts of the parish and deanery, recognizing the reduced number of priests to provide sacramental services, evaluating the potential effects of an aging population in our parishes and deanery, and including cost effective management of properties, many of which are aging faster than any of us might be doing. Watch for updates on this process and be ready to contribute whenever possible, to provide input when asked, and to prayerfully ask for God's guidance as we seek to enhance the church's role in the 21st century.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Using a Health App – Avoid Risks.

New health apps are popping up every day, promising to help you track your health conditions, count your calories, manage your medications, or predict your ovulation. These apps often ask for some of your most sensitive personal information, like your health history, medication list, or whether you have ever suffered a miscarriage. Some apps use that sensitive information only to give you services. But others may use it for their own research, to target you with ads, or disclose — or even sell — your data to other companies. And, unlike your doctor, these apps may not be covered by health privacy laws like HIPAA.


