Dear people of God,

As your pastor, and despite being gone for much of this month, I wanted to provide you with a summary report of last year's fiscal situation. Of course, along with that goes a very sincere *thank you* to those who supported the parish even through the thick of a pandemic so that I can say we are definitely above water relative to income and spending. Since some of us prefer to wade through the details, the Comprehensive Report we file with the Diocese is included in today's bulletin.

Areas of income

Weekly Collections - \$113,758  
Outreach income – \$15,135  
Reverse Raffle – \$14,260  
Other income – \$36,676  
Total for the year – \$179,829

Areas of expense

Wages, Salaries – \$67,540  
Payroll taxes/fringes - \$14,514  
Liturgy related – \$3,808  
Utilities – \$18,129  
Insurance - \$11,256  
Taxes/licenses – \$7,964  
Diocesan Assessment – \$17,853  
Outreach Expense (food delivery) - \$1,022  
Other expenses – \$22,395  
Total expenses – \$164,481

The “other income” item includes a variety of collections, the Payroll Protection loan (forgiven by the government), and a few extraordinary donations. “Other expenses” includes lawn care, snow removal, and a few other upkeep items around the church. My thanks to all who are regular contributors. We ended the year \$15,000 to the good and this will enable us to undertake some other upkeep and maintenance projects so that our campus will be safe, secure, and comfortable for all of us. I also challenge those who do not regularly support the parish to do so. We have a couple of really large “big ticket” items not included in the Capital Campaign that we'd like to tackle including protection glass on the windows and replacement of the front doors.

**The Celebration of Sacraments**

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
