Dear People of God,





I'm sure many of you will recall a mention in the bulletin of discovering a "Chamber of Secrets" (with due credit for that title to JK Rowling) under the parking area to the east of the church. To prevent any future collapse of the concrete roof, the paving company wants to fill it with stone, but when they peered into the stygian depths, they saw some items down there and informed us. Not too long afterward we sent an intrepid explorer down into the closed-off room to see what was there and take a few photos. The room was originally accessible via some steps along the east wall of the church sacristy. There was a door into the church basement at the foot of the steps (visible in the basement) and the door into the chamber is sealed with concrete blocks as seen in the photo. The window at left was removed from the wall so there must have been a window well covered over when the driveway was paved.

The two barrels are empty and rusting as is everything else in the chamber. The other side of the room was built against a stone-and-brick wall suggesting there may have been some need for a supporting structure where the sacristy meets the main body of the church, seen at right.

Following the fire, a lot of original structure got hidden away. If you look up into the choir loft, you'll see two large, white panels which cover up the enclosed windows which were there to allow light from tower windows to help brighten the loft in the days before electric lighting (there were two in the main church on either side of the building, now bricked over). This last photo is up in the west tower where that original window has been bricked in. The rickety

looking ladder (it is, by the way) would take one up to the bell level from there and а similar ladder will get one to the roof top where there's a great view of Downtown and South Toledo. This window was similar in shape to the rose window still gracing the front façade. These intriguing discoveries remind us that our beloved parish has a long history with some secrets we may never unlock but also is a timely stimulus for our appreciation of the sound construction which has enabled decades of prayerful worship and a unifying sense of community.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
