Dear People of God,

In light of the tragedy unfolding in Ukraine, I will interrupt my series on the seven deadly sins to share with you the Ukrainian National Anthem. It seems particularly apt to the situation there and is founded on the Christian virtue of Hope.

Yemen, Ethiopia, Sudan, Eritrea, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Columbia, Venezuela, Somalia, Kenya, Democratic Republic of Congo, Uganda, Nigeria, Algeria, Burkina Faso, Chad, Libya, Tunisia, Togo, Benin, Ivory Coast, Rwanda, Burundi, Mexico (34,000+ deaths in 2021), Cameroon, South Sudan, Central African Republic, Mozambique, India, Pakistan, Gaza Strip, Israel, Lebanon, Indonesia, Philippines, Turkey, Egypt, Thailand and Bangladesh.

These are the major hot spots; there are many more where violence is localized and has led to only a few deaths. Please pray that the Prince of Peace might vanquish war and violence in all these too many places.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Please bring donated items to Church and place in the bin or drop off at the Outreach center on Tuesdays or Wednesdays. Please do not leave items if no one is there.









