Dear People of God,

Today churches all across the nation are honoring those who stand on duty to protect and to serve and, as a special intention, we pray for the repose of the souls of those who made the ultimate sacrifice on behalf of their communities. Locally, Immaculate Conception's sister parish, Historic St. Patrick's, has become the site for one of the area's primary celebrations: representatives of diverse police stations along with friends and relatives gather for an annual *blue* mass. Today we join with them in prayer as we recognize the bravery and sacrifice of our society's protectors. I sign a note of condolence to each department which has experienced the loss of one of its own and there are far more of them than one might think. It's a dangerous profession and I know you join me in giving thanks to those intrepid men and women who are willing to stand up daily to make our lives more secure.

We might think only of the city police or the sheriff's department, but there are many jurisdictions which provide protective services. Here in Toledo you can find US Marshals, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Ohio Highway Patrol, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation, the Federal Border Patrol (yes, we have an international border right here in Toledo), the ATF police, railroad police, refinery police, private security guards and perhaps others with which I am not familiar. Each demands a high level of formation and experience with on-going training to assure that you and I can rest as easily as possible.

It's a difficult assignment, especially today when violence on our streets and in our homes has risen to unprecedented levels: drive by shootings, assaults on the sidewalks, domestic violence, cases of abuse and negligence that would break the hardest heart seem too often to make the news. I imagine the emotional toll is incredible and certainly offer my sincere thanks personally and on behalf of all of us to those who are willing to face all of this every day.

May God hold them in the hollow of his hand so that their work can be done safely and effectively and bring them safely back to their families and loved ones. All of us here at Immaculate Conception have them in our prayers, not just today but always.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Historic South Initiative Home Repair Program

Historic South Initiative's home repair program helps residents in the Old South End repair issues to the outside of their home that are related to lead hazards, safety, and sanitation. The following repairs qualify:

New windows and/or doors

New siding and/or painting

Roof repair and/or replacement

Gutter replacement

Exterior asbestos removal

Once an application is received and approved, Historic South will inspect the home and determine what can be done. A grant to the resident is then awarded based on income. The average grant is \$15,000.

To qualify, you must meet these requirements:

- Be in the target area of I-75 highway to Broadway to Walbridge Ave, back to I-75.
- Be the owner of the property.
- Be current on home taxes. If not current, must make a down payment towards a payment plan and pay up to 3 months before being eligible.
- House having a sound structural quality.




