Dear People of God,

It's budget season here at the parish and planning for ministries, liturgies and maintenance is no easy task given the fluctuations we've seen over the past years, some due to Covid and others to the rising rate of inflation. For the typical family, budgeting is fairly simple since we often know well ahead of time what our income is going to be so can assess which expenses we can pay and when. At home we do our best to steward our income to meet ordinary needs and set something aside for unexpected repairs, vacations and retirement.

Here at the parish we're a family and we do our best to steward our resources wisely and well. However, the parish family consists of hundreds of households, each with an income it is aware of but which is not known to us who are doing our best to meet ordinary expenses and anticipate those unexpected repairs. How good it would be if at the beginning of the budgetary year, we knew what we were going to see in terms of income so we could intelligently address outgo!

Several years before Covid struck, we attempted to begin an offertory pledge program so that each household could let us know what it might be able to do to help the entire parish thrive and grow. I'd like to propose that we give it another look so that you as a householder and we as a parish can plan ahead and do our best to meet the needs of home and church. I invite everyone to take time to pray, to seek God's guidance and perhaps hear his gentle whisper to trust in Him who provides for the needs of all. Any offertory program should be based in our faith, in our trust and in our hope that the Lord will be there to provide for us.

I invite you to take a look at the Commitment Card enclosed in today's bulletin. Given the effects of inflation, which is hurting us as a parish family as much as it does you as a householder, how much can you give on a weekly basis as a gift to God in thanks for his gifts to you? How much do you trust God to provide you with enough to give back to Him? Your kind response, whether large or small, should be realistic and will certainly help us to plan for the days ahead so that the parish can be warm in winter, clean all year round and open for the liturgies and ministries you count on to be available. As your pastor I don't expect anyone to commit to what they cannot afford nor does this estimate constitute a contractual commitment, but I do urge everyone to honestly consider what they can afford and do your best to continue making this parish a sustainable place we can be proud of.

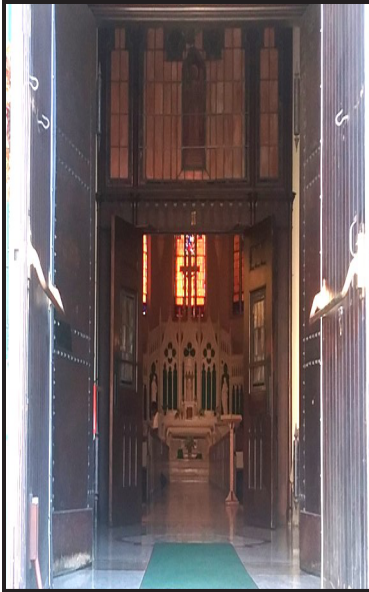
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Historic South Initiative Home Repair Program

Historic South Initiative's home repair program helps residents in the Old South End repair issues to the outside of their home that are related to lead hazards, safety, and sanitation. The following repairs qualify:

- New windows and/or doors
- New siding and/or painting
- Roof repair and/or replacement
- Gutter replacement
- Exterior asbestos removal

Once an application is received and approved, Historic South will inspect the home and determine what can be done. A grant to the resident is then awarded based on income. The average grant is \$15,000.

To qualify, you must meet these requirements:

- Be in the target area of I-75 highway to Broadway to Walbridge Ave, back to I-75.
- Be the owner of the property.
- Be current on home taxes. If not current, must make a down payment towards a payment plan and pay up to 3 months before being eligible.
- House having a sound structural quality.

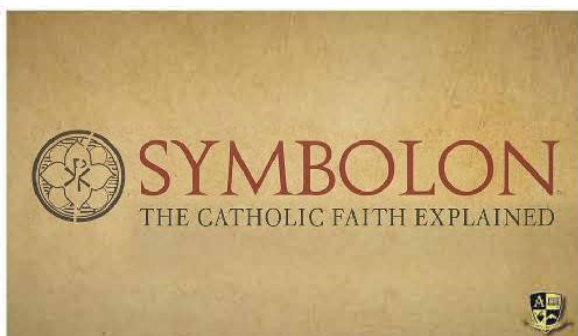
THE WILD GOOSE: GOD'S LOVE POURED OUT

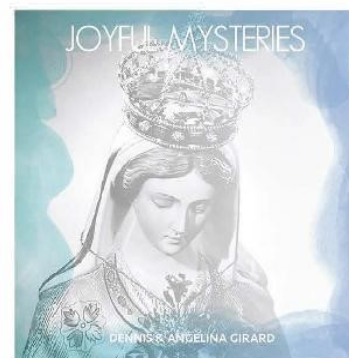
