Dear People of God,

Today we celebrate the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, the gift of himself, of his real presence, entering into our lives to reveal the spiritual realm of the Kingdom of God. It is also the beginning of a three-year preparatory period leading up to a national Eucharistic Congress to be held in near-by Indianapolis from July 17-21, 2024. The year ahead of us is slated to be a year of evangelization and catechesis on the Real Presence centered on diocesan-wide and parish events which help us learn more about the real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament so that we can better understand the richness of what occurs when we share at the table of the Lord. The USCCB (Bishop's Conference) will be providing all kinds of great resources and there are many more available on FORMED which can certainly open our eyes, ears and hearts to the real presence of Jesus. At the Congress there will be a festival atmosphere similar to that experienced at World Youth Day with activities, teaching, processions, musical stages around the city and an opportunity to meet and pray with as many as 80,000 official delegates and hundreds of thousands of others attending all or part of the event. As I mentioned, it's close to us here in Toledo – a straight shot down "Port to Fort" and then I-69 to Indy, 230 miles or three and a half hours driving. As Pastor I will be urging as many as possible to be there.

As I'm sure you know, the real presence of Jesus is the bedrock of our Church – we truly believe that Jesus Christ is present in each of the seven sacraments and that his presence is imparted in some special way to us as we celebrate any of the seven. However, Catholic teaching tells us that the most profound manifestation of the real presence is in the Eucharist. The Church refers to the Eucharist as both source and summit of the Christian's way of life: we are empowered by the real presence to seek ever more deeply the real presence. That being the case, the evangelization of the Eucharist begins here and now with an invitation to everyone simply to participate with a heart open to actually feeling Jesus enter within and change oneself and to be part of the praying community which respects the presence of Jesus in all others present at the celebration and the unity which results as we truly form ourselves into the Body of Christ here in the parish. Open yourself to the many aspects of this preparatory phase – get involved – look forward to 2024 – start planning now for your pilgrimage to Indianapolis. Having been a regular pilgrim to World Youth Day for many seasons, I can tell you, you won't regret it.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.



Historic South Initiative Home Repair Program

Historic South Initiative's home repair program helps residents in the Old South End repair issues to the outside of their home that are related to lead hazards, safety, and sanitation. The following repairs qualify:

New windows and/or doors

New siding and/or painting

Roof repair and/or replacement

Gutter replacement

Exterior asbestos removal

Once an application is received and approved, Historic South will inspect the home and determine what can be done. A grant to the resident is then awarded based on income. The average grant is \$15,000. To qualify, you must meet these requirements:

Be in the target area of I-75 highway to Broadway to Walbridge Ave, back to I-75.

Be the owner of the property.

Be current on home taxes. If not current, must make a down payment towards a payment plan and pay up to 3 months before being eligible.

House having a sound structural quality.




