Dear People of God,

Over the past months I have been given some advanced information about a Diocesan-wide Capital Campaign. It launched about a year ago with a pilot phase involving ten or so parishes and a personal drive by the Bishop to bring in a hefty "down payment" on the campaign's overall goal. Because our turn as well as that of several others in this area has come, you'll be hearing a lot about it from the Bishop, from me as your pastor, and from members of the parish who are dedicated to the Church both here and across our diocese. So far the campaign has done really well with participating parishes far exceeding their goal.

Our parish kick-off is coming in August and the period during which we hope to solicit your kind assistance will be through the autumn months. The parish will receive 35% of funds realized which are to be applied to capital projects right here at home. You'll be provided a case study outlining what our diocese hopes to accomplish and what we can do for ourselves. It's a doable project which I pray all of us will support, encourage and assist. Watch for the details coming next month.

On another note, having been away for a long-awaited trip to the Emerald Isle, I know that many others are also enjoying some time away. Summer vacation, the cottage, Cedar Point, weekend camping – all of these are great activities which can regenerate our energy to be about the business of family, work and self-development. However, all too often people forget that we are humans who consist of body (a nice dip in the pool), mind (a good book or movie) and soul (a connection to God) and fail to attend to that third reality, the soul. Summer is not a time to abandon the Church and its worship of the God of love, the God of salvation, the God who promises us the resurrection. If we're traveling, visiting a new and different community of faith can recharge our spiritual batteries, expose us to new hymns and songs, and perhaps let us hear a homily that touches us in a special way. Our presence at that different place can also bring some new life to that parish church just by our being the "Stranger who is welcomed." We hope to see many visitors here at the parish and we hope you'll be seen visiting some other parish as you take time to relax over the summer months.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory at Historic St. Patrick @ 419-243-6452.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
