Dear People of God,

Over the past several months I have been preparing us for our parish participation in the Living Christ Capital Campaign. The time is now drawing near when we will begin the second phase of the effort. Each phase involves around a third of the parishes of the diocese and asks that we all prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift in addition to our ordinary Sunday offerings and other fund raising programs of the parish and diocese. Each household will receive a case statement which outlines the goals for the diocese and those we hope to accomplish here in the parish with our portion of the funds raised. The pledge period is over a five-year span so you might want to consider that the parish goal is one and a half times the average of the last three years Sunday collection; your own personal goal might also be one and a half times your annual giving spread out over those five years.

I'm not the world's best mathematician, but I can do a quick division and discover that the yearly goal is not a huge threat to my existence and won't seriously challenge my ability to pay my bills. In the case statement you'll find a breakdown of a variety of giving levels: if you give \$1,000 a year, then the hope is you'll prayerfully consider \$1,500 (1.5 x your \$1000 average) or \$300 each year over the 5 yr. pledge plan. I know there are 52 weeks in a year so each week that would be about \$5.77 each Sunday. About \$2.00 of that would remain in the parish to be used for our own special needs. I ask that you please get out your calculator and discover what your own weekly gift might be and then pray about it until you receive the case study materials. If you think it too much, consider what you pay each month for your cell phone (a lot more than the \$2.65 our family paid for its phone when I was still at home) and if you pledged that same amount, we'd go far beyond our goal and be able to accomplish even more.

Parish Team Leaders will be given a training session soon and in mid-August, many of our leaders and parishioners will be invited to the cathedral gym for a dinner with the Bishop who will formally "kick off" our phase of the campaign. Having been on the College of Consultors during the preparatory period, I have been involved actively in making this program a success because I know that the case being made for the diocese is a good one which focuses on expanding services, assuring we can adequately prepare seminarians for priesthood, enhancing retirement sustainability for parish employees and teachers, strengthening existing ministries and attending to some long overdue work to maintain our beautiful cathedral as one of America's finest. Watch for your copy of the case statement, welcome parish visitors to you home if asked, and please pray for the campaign. Phase one, by the way, has brought the overall pledges to about 40% of the overall goal so let's do our best to do our part.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
