Dear People of God,

May the Risen Lord bless you this Easter season.

Easter is the triumphal conclusion to the period of prayerful preparation called Lent and as such, draws us ever more deeply into the Paschal Mystery of Christ's abundant love for his People. It's a day for celebrating the gift of redemption, the forgiveness of our transgressions, and the promise of our own experience of Resurrection one day in the future. There are ample distractions which might lead us to minimize the importance of the day. After all, Easter eggs for the children, the aroma of the baking ham, or friends and family stopping by to partake of our hospitality (or we theirs) can quickly overwhelm the quiet mystery of God's presence and promise so that what we experienced and heard at Mass sinks deep into the past rather than frames the activities of the entire day. Take time to relish what Jesus has accomplished for you and give proper thanks.

Here at the parish any number of volunteers have been about the business of making the church shine and all of the liturgies assume their full importance in our experience of salvation history. There were the people who cleaned, dusted and polished. There were the decorators who enhanced our already beautiful worship space. There were the ministers of the Mass who provided readers, servers, ushers, Eucharistic Ministers, sacristans, choir and musicians. There were those who, weeks before, began planning liturgical celebrations, recruiting volunteers and otherwise making things ready for these festival days. There were the kind volunteers who stayed after Mass to organize for the next important moment in Holy Week and Easter. I suspect few of us ever bother to count the number of people actively involved in making the Mass function well, many behind the scenes so that their number is difficult to see from the pews but who are able to point out and remedy a missing link in the expected operations of ministry. Please give thanks for the many who volunteer and rather than complain about what doesn't happen to your liking or expectation, volunteer to make it happen. The parish needs everyone to be involved or to be willing to be involved.

Having shared in the Eucharistic Presence of the Risen Lord, let us all go forth renewed and excited, anxious not just for that big Easter dinner but for the opportunity to share the good news of resurrection, Jesus' and ours.

Again, God's blessings on this wonderful day.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Health News for April 9, 2023



Who Gets Colorectal Cancer? Colorectal cancer occurs most often in men and women who are 45 years old or older, and the risk increases with age. If you are 45 or older, talk to your health care provider about getting screened. You may be at increased risk

- You or a close relative have had colorectal polyps or colorectal cancer.
- You have inflammatory bowel disease, Crohn's disease, or ulcerative colitis.
- You have a genetic syndrome such as familial adenomatous polyposis (FAP) or hereditary nonpolyposis colorectal cancer (Lynch syndrome).

People at risk for colorectal cancer may need earlier or more frequent tests than other people. If you think you may be at increased risk, talk to your health care provider about the routine screening tests that are right for you.
