#### Dear People of God,

This weekend we celebrate Mother's Day. I certainly wish all mothers and those who are filling in for mothers a blessed and very pleasant day. I would urge everyone to give Mom a call or stop by the cemetery and pay respects to those who have gone on ahead to the Kingdom. While flowers are nice, your presence is the miracle your mother remembers for the day you were born.

Mother's Day was established as a religious celebration of thanks for mothers who bore us, raised us, fed us, changed us, and set us on our way. It was first celebrated here in the United States 12 May 1907 and within a few years became a federally-recognized day of prayer and thanksgiving. Today it's a time to honor our moms with a card, flowers, candy, maybe a dinner at a nice restaurant or with some other lavish gift expressing our appreciation for all moms do for us.

Again, as Catholics we believe that all mothers, those who choose when to have a child and those who are surprised by an unexpected pregnancy, might truly love the children they bear and see each of them as a blessing for Mom, family, Church and world. We recall that God called us by name before we were born and we pray that moms will always call their children to their hearts with joy and happiness, not just today but every day.

On another note, though, we of the Catholic faith have been celebrating Mother's Day from the very beginning. Jesus speaks tenderly to his Mother from the Cross and Mary, the Mother of God, is mentioned in all of the Eucharistic Prayers, celebrated in the Rosary, and called upon by millions who revere her as an intercessor who speaks for us before the throne of God. Across the diocese we celebrate Mary our mother at the cathedral and in numerous parishes dedicated to God's mother. At Queen of the Apostles, where I provide sacramental services, our young people are learning about Mary as a caring, wonderful person who will always be there for them as a friend and mother image.

Moms are great – none of us would be here without one. Sometimes the world treats them harshly; some may even think less of them but today, let's all say a prayer for our mothers and for mothers everywhere, especially those where disease, war, pestilence and natural disasters make motherhood so much more difficult than it will ever be for most of our own mothers. Happy Day to all mothers. May God reward you for you ministry of love and devotion even when we don't deserve it!

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office. **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. **Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




We are looking for a few volunteers to place flags around the perimeter of the church on Friday, May 24th. Call the office or see Mary Jo at one of the masses!


