Dear People of God,

We're taking a refresher course on the sacraments of the New Dispensation (Christianity) and today we'll look at the second of the three sacraments of initiation: Confirmation. Wait, I hear you say: Isn't Confirmation the fourth sacrament we receive (Baptism, First Penance and First Eucharist)? For children that is the case; however, if you look at the rites for the initiation of adults, you'll discover that Confirmation is (and must be) administered immediately after Baptism.

The form of confirmation is brief: "\_(name)\_, be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit." The matter is the imposition of hands. For a small number of people at the Easter vigil, it is exactly that: the hands of the one administering the sacrament on the head of the person being confirmed, and anointing with Chrism. If, as was the case for the confirmation of our young people a few weeks ago, the number is large, the imposition is done generally by the bishop extending his hands over the group to be confirmed. For adults Confirmation replaces the second of the two anointings a baby or young child would receive. At the Baptism of children, that second anointing with chrism is a cross signed on the top of the head but at Confirmation it's the sign of the Cross on the forehead, an obvious confirmation of the initial sign given as Baptism begins.

As with Baptism there are some additional rituals. There is a longer prayer calling down the Holy Spirit and a repetition of the baptismal promises or Profession of Faith. For adults, the Profession is as follows:

I, \_name\_, with firm faith believe and profess each and everything that is contained in the Symbol of faith, namely:

(the Nicene Creed)

With firm faith, I also believe everything contained in the word of God, whether written or handed down in Tradition, which the Church, either by a solemn judgment or by the ordinary and universal Magisterium, sets forth to be believed as divinely revealed.

I also firmly accept and hold each and everything definitively proposed by the Church regarding teaching on faith and morals.

Moreover, I adhere with religious submission of will and intellect to the teachings which either the Roman Pontiff or the College of Bishops enunciate when they exercise their authentic Magisterium, even if they do not intend to proclaim these teachings by a definitive act.

Those added few lines are a specific expression of faith in the Catholic ecclesial community.

# The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




