Dear friends and families returning for Homecoming,

Today is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception which will be separately celebrated tomorrow by the Universal Church (you may wish to join the students of Queen of Apostles at 9 am or the families of Historic St. Patrick at 5:30 tomorrow). Under the title Immaculate Conception, Mary is the Patroness of the United States and deserves our respect and our trust that she hears our prayers and takes them to the throne of God.

Mary's Immaculate Conception is a declared truth: that means we must accept it as true if we claim to be real Catholics. The underlying basis for this is that God did a favor for Mary and spared her the stain of original sin which the rest of us inherit as children of Adam and Eve. The favor is certainly noted in the angelic greeting "hail full of grace," since to be full of grace means there can be no sin. Why did God do that favor? Because Mary was to be the vessel in which Jesus was conceived and developed over the nine months of her pregnancy. Jesus, who is God, does not tolerate sin so we can believe that he made sure his mother was sinless when he was conceived.

The Immaculate Conception is one of the reasons the Church does not believe there should be abortion on demand. Mary, a human person, was sinless at her conception months before she was born and years before Jesus was born. Jesus, a human person, was both God and human from the moment of his own conception. Each of us is a distinct human person created in the image and likeness of God from the moment of our own conception. That's the theological point of view.

The festival day isn't just about Mary but shows forth the fulfillment of the promise of God that all of us will one day be freed permanently from the bonds of sin. No more thinking bad thoughts or doing bad things, only the knowledge of what is good and the will to do it. Given the amount of bad stuff we can read about in the paper or see on TV, all of us should look forward to the day that liberation happens!

Today here at the parish is also Homecoming, an opportunity for families to gather once again at the corner of Eastern and Maumee to celebrate the faith as one, Darby forever and Mary our Mother. Welcome to all who return for our celebration; your presence gives those who remain great strength and hope in a future in which Immaculate Conception thrives and continues to offer the blessings of God to the community.

The Celebration of Sacraments

<u>Infant Baptism</u>: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call the church @ 419-243-1829.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. at IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Snow Emergency




Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in the geographic area are also cancelled.




Blessed Carlo Acutis statue dedication

Please join us as we celebrate the addition of this beautiful piece of art that was designed by the 2024 8th Grade Class of Queen of Apostles. These students undertook to become familiar with the two patrons of the Universal Church's Eucharistic Renewal and immediately were drawn to Blessed Carlo Acutis, a young teen who by the age of fifteen when he died had researched and developed two magnificent poster collections, one focused on the Eucharistic Miracles and another on Mary's numerous apparitions. 
